Dear Ms. Garfield:

As a result of Hurricane Hanna, which occurred beginning on July 25, 2020, many homes and businesses were affected in Hidalgo County, Texas, creating an economic emergency for the residents of the county.

Pursuant to the provisions of 15 U.S.C. § 636(b)(2) and 13 C.F.R. § 123.3(a), I request that the Small Business Administration declare Hidalgo County a disaster area for the purpose of making long-term, low-interest rate physical disaster home and business loans, as well as economic injury disaster loans, available to citizens and businesses affected by the disaster. A preliminary survey indicates there are more than 34 homes and/or businesses in Hidalgo County that suffered an uninsured loss of more than 40 percent.
