CR-101 FILED TO PROPOSE AMENDING SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 388-78A WAC

Dear Assisted Living Facility Administrator and Interested Parties:

This notification is to announce the filing of CR-101 to consider amending WAC 388-78A-2524(1), -2525(1), and -2526(1) sections for the certificate of training requirements for administrators required under WAC 388-78A-2521 to identify the period of time portions of these rules were suspended or waived during the declared emergency of COVID-19 for the Assisted Living Facility Licensing rules.

A CR-101 (WSR 20-17-085) was filed with the Office of the Code Reviser on August 20, 2020 to begin the rulemaking process.
