

Chair, National Democratic Redistricting Committee


Holder is an internationally-recognized leader on a broad range of legal issues . He served in the Obama Administration as the 82nd Attorney General of the United States from February 2009 to April 2015, the third-longest serving Attorney General in U.S. history and the first African American to hold that office.

Beginning her career as a chemist, Nelson is now a regional expert on diversity and inclusion. A lecturer at Harvard Law School, Greenwood has litigated two partisan gerrymandering cases from the trial level to the Supreme Court of the United States (Whitford v. Gill and LWVNC v. Rucho). She has also advised dozens of states on how to draft and implement independent redistricting commissions.
