SUBJECT: Summary and statistical report of Lake Winnebago

sturgeon spearing for 1950.

Sturgeon Tags Sold:

The license section states that 2, 25 sturgeon tags were sold. This is a drop of approximately 5,000 tags and would be attributed to the increase in sale price of from five cents to one dollar per tag.

Number of Fishermen:

From the lists, 2,019 licensees purchased tags, or there were 1.20 tags per fisherman - a drop of about 3 tags per fisherman, indicative of the increased tag price.

Tegree of Fisherman Success:

As reported, there were 117 sturgeon taken, which meant only 39 percent fishermen reporting, or about one of every four fishermen reporting took at least one fish. The following table supports the preceding discussion.

Sex Ratio and Other Observations:

The census cards showed that a ratio of 73 males to 28 females prevailed in the 101 sturgeons reported taken. Accompanying this report, I have also included a sturgeon male and female distribution chart relative to weight and length grouping of the species. The following averages were tabulated from the groupings.
