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11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4002.1 of Title 69, unless there
14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. In order to achieve efficiencies in the operations of the
16	Oklahoma Turnpike Authority and the Oklahoma Department of
17	Transportation, this section authorizes shared functions between two
18	entities. The Authority shall nevertheless remain a body corporate
19	and constituting an instrumentality of this state pursuant to
20	Section 1701 et seq. of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and shall
21	retain all corporate powers set forth in the Oklahoma Turnpike
22	Authority Enabling Act, for so long as any bonds, notes or other
23	obligations of the Authority remain outstanding and are not fully
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1 discharged. Nothing contained in this act shall be deemed to limit 2 or alter in any way the rights and obligations of the Authority:

- 1. To fulfill and observe all requirements of any trust agreement, indenture or resolution authorized by the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority Enabling Act including, but not limited to, collection and application of tolls and other revenues pledged thereunder;
- 2. To establish and collect such fees, rentals and other charges as may be necessary or required to produce sufficient revenues to meet and to fulfill the terms and provisions of the contracts made with the holders and owners of the bonds, notes or other obligations; or
- 3. In any way impair the constitutional rights of the holders and owners of the bonds, notes or other obligations of the Authority.
 - B. Pursuant to subsection A of this section:
- 1. The Director of the Department of Transportation and the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority are hereby authorized and empowered to contract with each other to provide personnel and equipment and other resources, either of the Department, the Authority or consulting or contracting firms for:
 - a. recordkeeping, reporting, administrative, planning, engineering, legal, financial and clerical functions, and

1	b. construction, operation and maintenance of turnpike
2	projects and highways of this state; and
3	2. The Authority shall retain its separate identity, powers and
4	duties as an instrumentality of the state. Duplication of effort,
5	facilities and equipment shall be minimized by the Authority and the
6	Director of the Department of Transportation in operation and
7	maintenance of turnpikes and highways of this state. The Authority
8	and the Department are authorized to take such action as necessary
9	to implement the provisions of this subsection, including the
10	temporary transfer of personnel, property and equipment from the
11	Authority to the Department and the Department to the Authority.
12	The charges for services shall be made on the basis of the total and
13	actual cost to the Authority and Department, as applicable, of all
14	wages, salaries, expenses, equipment rental, damage to equipment,
15	depreciation or other charges and expenses chargeable to the
16	services to be rendered by the Authority to the Department and the
17	Department to the Authority, or pursuant to contractual terms with
18	third parties.
19	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
