Robert Crown Community Center and Library Demolition of old Robert Crown Center

March 20, 2020

Demolition work planned to continue at the old Robert Crown Center. Mobilization and asbestos abatement work as already been completed and the demolition process is now moving into its next phase. Work is anticipated to occur as follows:

Week of 3/23 through week of 4/6: Dismantle, separate and haul away above grade portions of the

building

Week of 4/13 through week of 5/4: Excavate and remove building foundations

Demolition work will be conducted between 7:00 am and 3:00 pm Monday through Friday. Occasional work on Saturdays is possible depending on weather conditions and contractor progress.

During demolition work, the contractor will follow all OSHA requirements and the Cook County Environmental Control Ordinance to ensure the safety of both demolition workers and the general public. Water will be used extensively to control dust and dirt from becoming airborne. Ambient air monitoring will be performed by an independent environmental engineering firm to ensure air quality requirements are met. Vibration monitoring equipment has be installed to alert the contractor in the event construction related vibrations approach levels which could potentially damage adjacent structures.
