COVID-19 EMERGENCY HOME TENANT BASED RENTAL ASSISTANCE (TBRA) PROGRAM

Up to \$3,000 in Emergency Assistance to Renters

The City of Trenton's COVID-19 Emergency HOME Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) Program will provide financial assistance to low income individuals and families in the City of Trenton who experience financial hardship due to COVID-19. The program will provide one-time payments of up to \$3,000 per qualifying household to help pay past-due and/or upcoming rent and utilities from April 1 through December 30, 2020.

TO BE ELIGIBILE FOR ASSISTANCE:

- ✓ Must rent an apartment or house in the City of Trenton.
- ✓ Must have been a resident of the City of Trenton for at least three months prior to the application for assistance
- ✓ Must have a valid current written lease signed by the landlord
- ✓ Must be current on rent payments up until the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic – March 13, 2020
- Must have been employed at least half-time (20 hours per week) prior to being furloughed or laid off.
- ✓ Must be able to document a financial hardship that is directly related to COVID-19.
- ✓ Household income prior to March 13, 2020, was at or below 60 percent of the City of Trenton Area Median Income.
- ✓ Must be a US Citizen or have eligible immigration status
