Representatives from Saint Mary's College are seeking final approval to offer a new Exceptional Needs: Intense Intervention licensure program. This program proposal provides a new option for teacher candidates in the existing Elementary/Mild Intervention dual licensure program to obtain additional eligibility for an Intense Intervention license through a 4 + 1 pathway within the MAS Program. In addition to the Bachelor of Arts degree in Elementary Education (and eligibility for elementary/Mild Intervention licensure), program completers ultimately receive a Master of Autism Studies with additional eligibility for Indiana licensure in Intense Intervention.

Subject: University of Indianapolis – Early Childhood Education Program
