



APPLY TO SERVE AS THE VOLUNTEER MARYLAND AMERICORPS MEMBER AT TESS!

APPLICATIONS DUE AUGUST 27, 2021

Volunteer Maryland is now accepting applications for an AmeriCorps Member (ACM) to serve at the Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services' Takoma East Silver Spring ("TESS") Community Action Center for 2021-2022.

The ACM is responsible for building capacity and developing and implementing a volunteer program at TESS. This is accomplished by collaborating with low-income residents, staff, and partners to implement a volunteer plan that provides multiple levels of participation and engages community members. These efforts support the agency's "whole family" (young children, parents, and senior relatives) approach in Long Branch, which aims to strengthen the families served. Efforts will expand on current programs based at TESS, such as Financial Counseling, Senior Social, Groceries to Go, the Parenting Group, and free tax help. This is an 11-month, full-time (40 hours/week) position. The ACM service year is September 15, 2021 through August 2, 2022. ACMs are expected to complete 1,700 hours of service during the term and receive an education award upon completion, stipend, health coverage, and other benefits.

Volunteer Maryland AmeriCorps Member duties include:

- Promoting the active participation of the residents within communities.
- Developing program materials and advising the agency regarding volunteer practices.
- Recruiting, training, supervising, and recognizing volunteers.
- Working with the agency to develop partnerships to support its volunteer programs.
- Training volunteer leaders in best practices of volunteer management.

Fluency in a second language is strongly preferred.
