

## **EXECUTIVE ORDER #130**

## Relating to the Governor's Pardon Advisory Board

**WHEREAS,** Article V, Section 6 of the Wisconsin Constitution vests in the Governor the exclusive and discretionary power to grant reprieves, commutations, and pardons;

**WHEREAS,** a pardon carries a significant impact on an individual by restoring certain rights, providing greater work opportunities, and bestowing an official grant of forgiveness;

**WHEREAS,** I have made it a priority of my Administration to address the profound racial inequities in our State's criminal justice system;

**WHEREAS,** since the Governor's Pardon Advisory Board (Board) was reconstituted on June 12, 2019, I have granted over 260 pardons to individuals who have completed their sentences, paid their debt to society, and contributed positively to our communities; and

**WHEREAS,** I am committed to ensuring more individuals are eligible for a pardon, providing them an opportunity for a second chance at a better life.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State, hereby direct:

- 1. The Chair of the Board, as defined in Section 1 of Executive Order #30, shall have the discretion to forward an application for pardon directly to the Governor with a non-binding recommendation for a pardon, without a hearing or executive action by the Board if all of the following apply:
  - a. The submitted application meets the eligibility requirements and complies with Section 2 of Executive Order #30;
  - b. Sufficient time has elapsed to preclude depreciation of the severity of the applicant's offense or offenses; and
  - c. The eligible offense or offenses were nonviolent.
- 2. Executive Order #30 shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.
