Description of tour- Pine Hills was Indiana's 1st State dedicated Nature Preserve in 1969. The rugged hike will be ~2 miles long with two rock scrambling spots on top of the Devil's Backbone. The unique geology here are the best examples of incised meanders east of the Mississippi. Indiana State Parks has been doing some invasive species management work along the trail to Pine Hills which will be discussed. Bring snacks, water, and hiking stick if you have one.
