**Full-length course:
103C: Financial Aid and
College Applications**

Estimated to take approximately 5 - 6 hours per week to complete. Recommended for 3 CEUs (2 Professional Discipline CEU and 1 Digital Learning Competency CEU)**

Includes content on:

- College Admissions - Application Process
- Preparing for College Admissions Tests
- Guiding Parents and Students through the Complexities of Financial Aid
- Assisting with the Financial Aid Process

** Prerequisite for the Postsecondary Advising for Special Populations I: This course content assumes knowledge of the content covered in NCDPI/CFNC Go Alliance Academy courses I-III (Building a College-Going Culture for All Students; College, Career, and Academic Planning; and Financial Aid and College Applications). You should have taken courses I-III or have knowledge of the content covered in those courses prior to taking this course.*

*** Note that individual employing school districts must approve employee CEUs.*

Pre-Registration Information

Course cost is only \$35 including your certificate of participation. Those who pre-register will receive additional course information, including a link for payment, after pre-registration closes October 12th. Refunds will not be available.

Space is limited to the first 25 registrants per course, so please do not register if you will not be able to dedicate the amount of time needed each week to complete the course/modules. Participants can register for only one of the courses currently being offered due to the depth of the course work, time commitment required, and limited space availability.
