As part of an open investigation into allegations of engine compartment fires on vehicles equipped with ABS modules supplied by Mando, HMC began a joint investigation with the supplier on allegations of non-crash engine compartment fires on 2019-2021 Genesis G70 vehicles in foreign markets outside the U.S.

February - March 2021

On February 22, 2021, HMC informed NASO of its investigation findings. Based on the information received, on March 2, 2021, HMA convened its North American Safety Decision Authority ("NASDA") and decided to conduct a safety recall in the U.S. market to address the condition of non-crash engine compartment fires caused by internal shorting of the ABS module on the subject vehicles.

As of the date of this filing, Hyundai is not aware of any confirmed crashes or injuries attributable to the recall condition. No related vehicle fires have occurred in the U.S. Three (3) related vehicle fires have been confirmed in foreign markets.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: Customers can continue driving these vehicles; however Hyundai

recommends parking these vehicles outside and away from structures until the recall remedy is completed. Hyundai plans to notify owners to bring their vehicles to the nearest Hyundai dealership for replacement of

the ABS module fuse.

The remedy procedure will be performed at no charge. Hyundai will provide reimbursement to owners for repairs according to the plan

submitted on May 16, 2018.
