2022 IHCP Works annual seminar scheduled for October 11-13 in Indianapolis

The Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) and Gainwell Technologies invite Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) providers to attend the 2022 IHCP Works annual provider seminar. The in-person seminar begins Tuesday, October 11, and continues through Thursday, October 13. There is no cost for the seminar.

The seminar features three full days of valuable information. Topics include program overviews and specific program billing guidelines, as well as other important IHCP information. Sessions will be led by the FSSA, Anthem, CareSource, Managed Health Services (MHS), MDwise, UnitedHealthcare and Gainwell Technologies. Seminar registration

Providers are requested to register for the seminar online by visiting the <u>Workshop Registration</u> page at in.gov/ medicaid/providers. The registration page provides instructions, including the <u>Workshop Registration Tool Quick</u> Reference Guide. Registration for the IHCP Works annual provider seminar is a two-step process. During registration, you must first register for the seminar. After you have confirmed your registration, you must then register for each session you would like to attend. When providers register, they receive a registration confirmation immediately.

Session descriptions and the daily schedule are attached to this bulletin for your reference. A link to this information is also available on the <u>Provider Education Opportunities</u> page at in.gov/medicaid/providers. All registration is on a first-come, first-served basis, so sign up early.

Beginning September 23, presentations for all sessions will be accessible via the <u>2022 IHCP Works</u> page at in.gov/ medicaid/providers. Providers are advised to print paper copies of each presentation for reference, if desired. **Paper** copies of the presentations will *not* be provided at the seminar.

Walk-in registrations will be allowed; however, it is not recommended, as space is limited. The most popular sessions reach capacity well before the start of the seminar. Walk-in registrants will be allowed to attend sessions only if space is available.

Business casual attire is recommended for comfort. Consider layering to accommodate variations in room temperature. Beverage service will not be available; however, a restaurant, early morning coffee bar and snack shop are available at the facility where drinks, snacks and lunch can be purchased.



Session Name	Description
Behavioral Health (Presented by Anthem, CareSource, MDwise, MHS, UnitedHealthcare, Gainwell Technologies)	These presentations give information on the claim submission process for behavioral health services. Topics will include common denial reasons and how to avoid them.
Enrollment (Presented by Anthem, CareSource, MDwise, MHS, UnitedHealthcare, Gainwell Technologies)	These presentations give information on the enrollment and revalidation processes with a focus on resolving common errors quickly and efficiently.
Institutional Claims (UB-04) (Presented by Anthem, CareSource, MDwise, MHS, UnitedHealthcare, Gainwell Technologies)	These presentations give information on the claim submission process using the online portals for institution-based services.
Prior Authorization 101 (Presented by Anthem, CareSource, MDwise, MHS, UnitedHealthcare, Gainwell Technologies)	Each partner will present the basics of prior authorization (PA), including requirements, submission methods and provider recourse when a PA is denied. Each presentation may vary slightly.
Prior Authorization 201 (Presented by Anthem, CareSource, MDwise, MHS, UnitedHealthcare, Gainwell Technologies)	These presentations look more closely at specific prior authorization situations, such as retro-authorizations and new births. A more detailed look at appeals and disputes is included.

MDwise – Culturally and Linguistically Appropriate Services (CLAS)	MDwise presents an introduction to its Culturally and Linguistically Appropriate Services (CLAS), including how CLAS can be used in services to reduce health disparities.
