## Resources from Legal Aid of NC

Many households in North Carolina receive benefits from Food and Nutrition Services each month to provide food for their families. In March 2020, these households were provided with emergency allotments due to the pandemic. However, the emergency allotments are set to end at the end of February 2023. (For more information, read the NCDHHS Press Release from January 12, 2023)

With the extra food stamp (FNS/SNAP) payment, officially called Emergency Allotments, ending soon, families will only receive regular food stamp payment loaded to their EBT card: There will be no second payment later in the month. More concretely, this change is expected to result in families receiving a significant reduction in food assistance. At minimum, all households receiving food and nutrition assistance will see a reduction of \$95 per month in benefits. However, many households will experience a significantly larger reduction of benefits. It is estimated that on average households will experience a reduction of approximately \$82 per person per month after the end of these Emergency Allotments. TO put this in perspective, there are approximately 800,000 households that receive FNS/SNAP in North Carolina. On average, more than 70% of these households are families with children.

As part of our response to this impending crisis, LANC has complied the attached resource flyer and will be holding weekly clinics to help families understand the upcoming changes and navigate finding supplemental assistance in other forms if possible.
