MSCAB Officers and Directors

The MSCAB is the active administrative advisory committee of Mastick Senior Center. It provides advice and counsel on all matters connected with accomplishing the mission statement and serves as a spokesperson for the membership at large. The MSCAB advises the Recreation Manager on activities, schedules, services, projects, and programs desired for the Center.

The MSCAB undertakes fundraising activities to assist in the support of Center programs and directs the spending of these funds.

- The MSCAB meets once a month (10 months per year). Interested person must:
- Be a member of the Mastick Senior Center for at least 90 days in the current enrollment year prior to nomination
- Express an interest in the welfare of the Center and senior issues
- Actively create awareness and advocate on behalf of the Center
- Attend events and meetings
- Give approval and indicate his/her willingness to serve
