Eligibility

NCSD Summer Programs are offered to NCSD students and Deaf/Hard of Hearing students in grades PreK-12 in Western North Carolina. NCSD's goal is to strengthen language and social communication.

Day Campers - \$50 per week Dormitory Campers - \$100 per week

Day Option

Camp runs 7:30 AM - 3:30 PM M-Th 7:30 AM - 12:45 PM Friday Buses will run daily in the morning and afternoon to regional bus stops. Time and location information available at a later date. Breakfast, lunch, and snacks are provided.

Dormitory Option

Dormitory Campers will be picked up Sunday afternoon and dropped off on Friday afternoon at regional bus stops. Time and location information available at a later date.
