


Establishments

Between March 2020 and March 2021, 17,364 Wisconsin establishments opened and 13,698 closed, for a net increase of 3,666. Employment expanded at 33,539 establishments and contracted at 43,079. Small businesses accounted for 16,649 openings and 12,819 closings.


Employment

Opening and expanding Wisconsin establishments added 195,097 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 278,320, for a net decrease of 83,223 jobs. Small businesses gained 139,671 jobs and lost 196,096, for a net decrease of 56,425 jobs.

Thousands of jobs





Small business loans

The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$1.5 billion in loans to Wisconsin businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$1.6 billion. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$6.7 billion.



Small business exports

A total of 8,643 identified firms exported goods worth \$19.1 billion from Wisconsin in 2020. Of those exporters, 7,392—or 85.5 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$5.4 billion, making up 28.3 percent of exports by identified firms.


