NATIONAL WOMEN VETERANS RECOGNITION DAY JUNE 12th, 2023

WHEREAS, June 12, 2023, marks the 75th Anniversary of the Women's Armed Services Integration Act, signed into law by President Harry S. Truman on June 12, 1948; and
