The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a meeting of the Advisory Committee for the Clean Transportation Program Investment Plan. The meeting will discuss proposed funding allocations included in the revised staff draft report version of the *2023–2024 Investment Plan Update for the Clean Transportation Program*. This is a hybrid meeting consistent with Senate Bill 143 (Committee on Budget and Fiscal Review, Chapter 196, Statutes of 2023), with both a publicly accessible physical location and public access online or by phone through Zoom™.

## Background

Assembly Bill (AB) 118 (Núñez, Chapter 750, Statutes of 2007) created the Clean Transportation Program. The statute authorizes the CEC to develop and deploy alternative and renewable fuels and advanced transportation technologies to help attain the state's climate change policies. More recently, AB 126 (Reyes, Chapter 319, Statutes of 2023) reauthorized the Clean Transportation Program until July 1, 2035, along with changing some program requirements. For instance, AB 126 requires the CEC to allocate at least 15 percent of program funds in each fiscal year for hydrogen station development, unless certain exceptions apply.

Health & Safety Code § 44272.7 requires the CEC to annually update an investment plan for the Clean Transportation Program. Projects funded by the CEC under the program must be consistent with the priorities established in the investment plan. The Clean Transportation Program has an annual budget of approximately \$100 million and provides financial and technical support for projects including electric vehicle charging and hydrogen refueling infrastructure; workforce training; fuel production; local and regional planning; and in-state manufacturing for zero-emission vehicles and infrastructure.

In recent years, the CEC has also received state General Funds and Greenhouse Gas Reduction Funds. The investment plan update incorporates these funds as well as the base Clean Transportation Program funds to provide a holistic view of funding allocations.
