## Keep Caring Tool Kit – for Partners of Peterborough City Council



## **Overview**

'Keep Caring...' is a Peterborough and Cambridgeshire-wide campaign, which aims to share messaging relevant to the recovery and test and trace phases that will dominate the next few months leading into the winter 2020/2021. The campaign's key aim is to continue to prevent the spread of coronavirus and to protect all our communities in both local authority areas. With lockdown fatigue now evident across different audiences since restrictions eased on 4 July (including pubs, restaurants, cinemas etc), there is a need to remind people that complacency can risk transmission and endanger lives and there are things that we all can do to keep everyone safe. **This tool kit contains specific messaging around people visiting other people.**
