UPDATE: ECATS Change - "Per Reporting Period"

The EC Division is organizing a technical assistance package to support the transition from the use of "Per Reporting Period" as an option to describe the frequency of services. Please be reminded that the EC Division is not requiring LEAs to review and revise current IEPs in anticipation of this change.

The EC Division has also heard concerns and considered requests for additional time for local training to occur before removing this option. Therefore, the sunset date for removing "Per Reporting Period" from ECATS will now be **September 15, 2021** rather than July 1, 2021. With the extension of time and the aforementioned technical assistance package, it is hoped this will support PSUs to a smoother transition for this change.

UPDATE: Service Documentation Module

As part of an ongoing effort to streamline functionality in the ECATS Service Documentation module, we will be removing elements in the module that currently exist only to support Medicaid claiming. While much of the data in the Service Documentation module supports Medicaid claiming, it is not primarily designed as a claim preparation tool. The primary purposes of the Service Documentation module are to organize and capture data on IEP service delivery, support ongoing intervention planning, support progress monitoring/reporting, and support program monitoring and service verification.

As such, as of May 24, 2021, the following elements will be removed from the Service Documentation module:

- Medicaid One Time Consent/Annual Notification
- Physician Authorization Event/Tracking
- "No Ability to Bill" user type modifier

LEAs will need to incorporate these elements in their Medicaid claiming platform/process.
