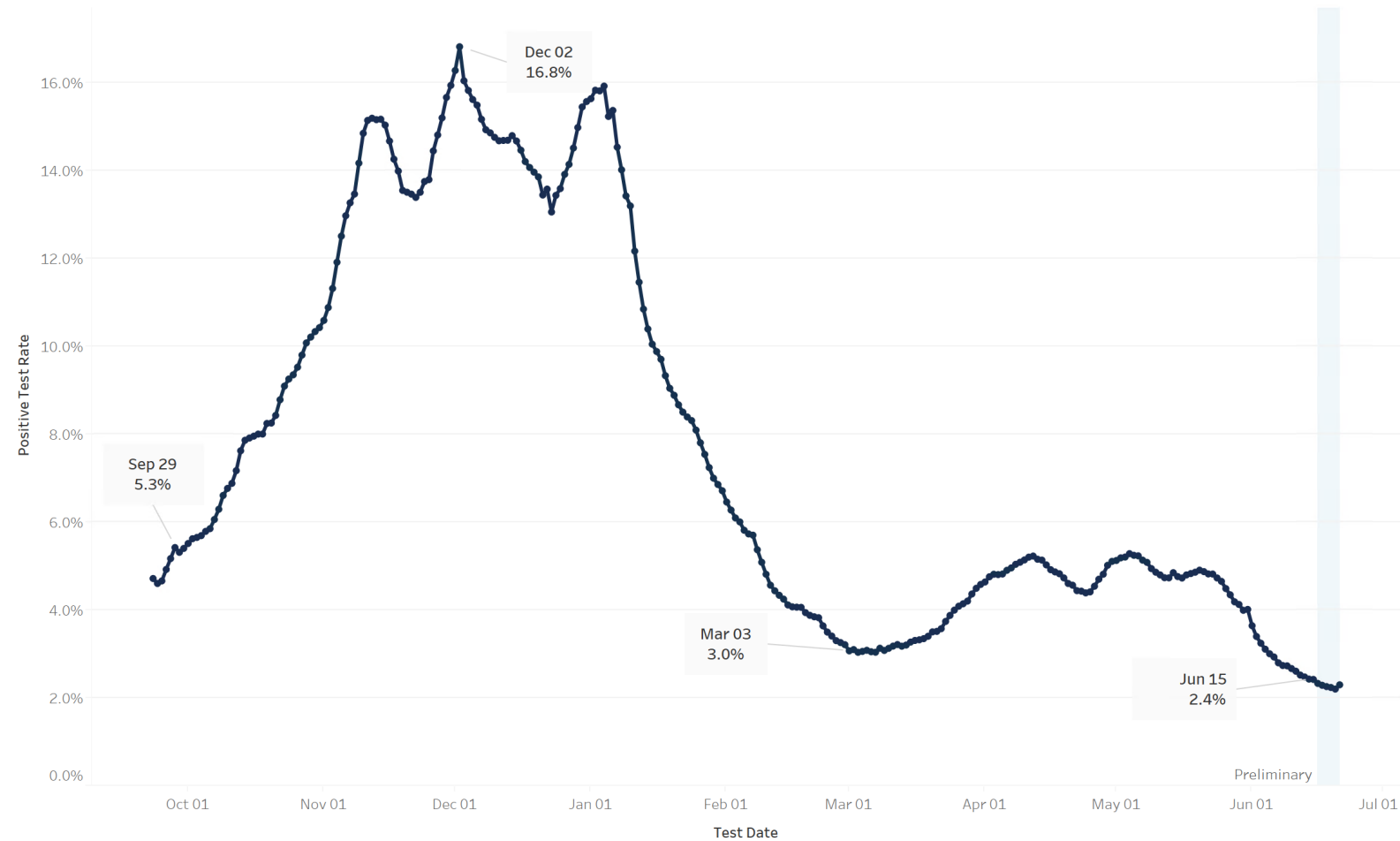

7-Day Moving Average, September 23, 2020 to Present

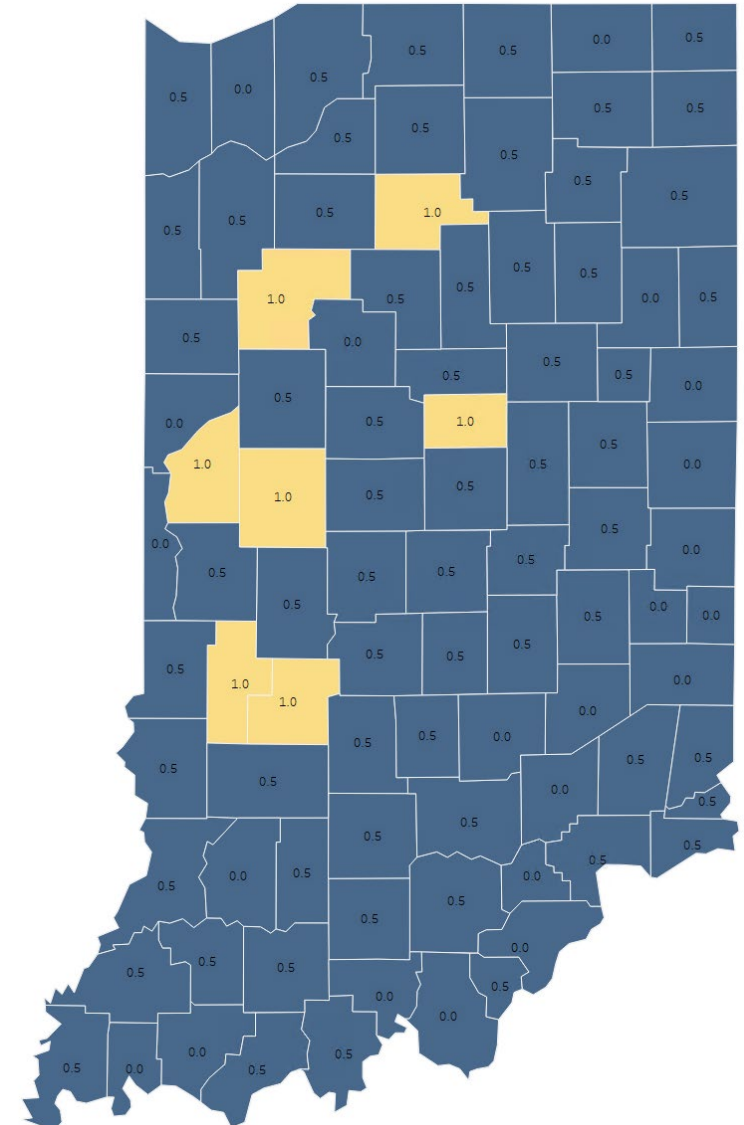
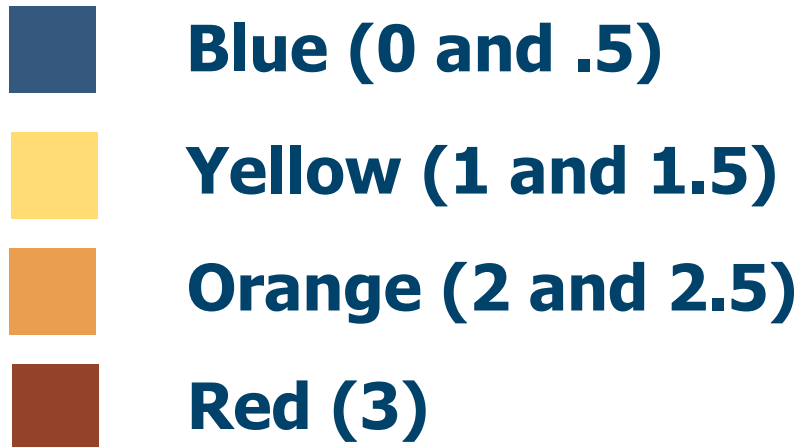

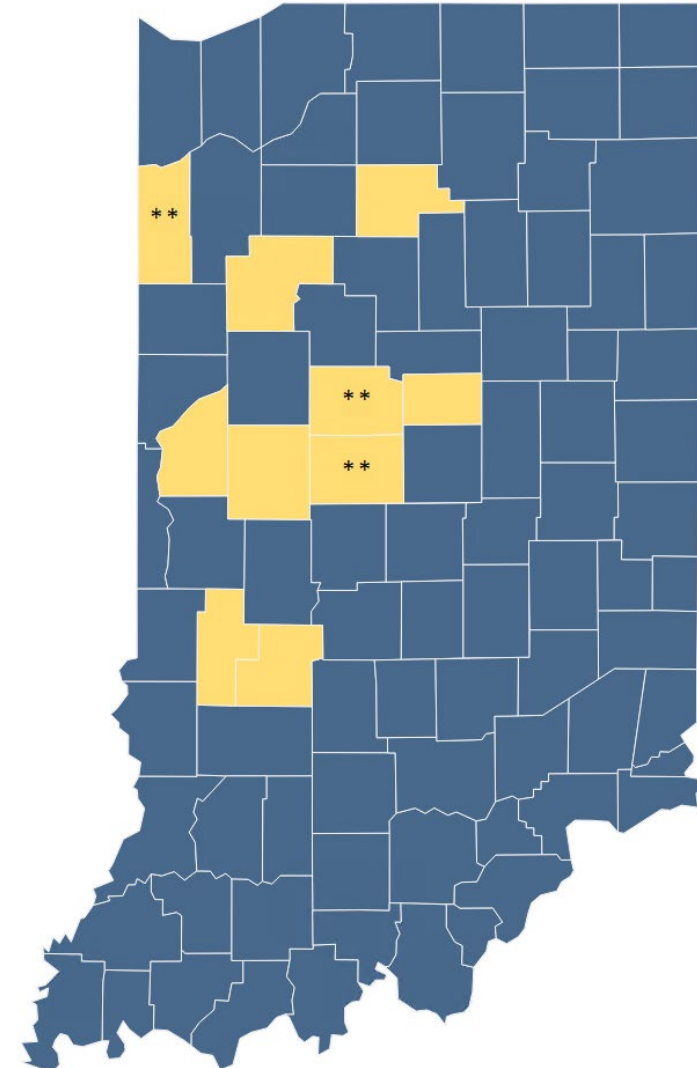

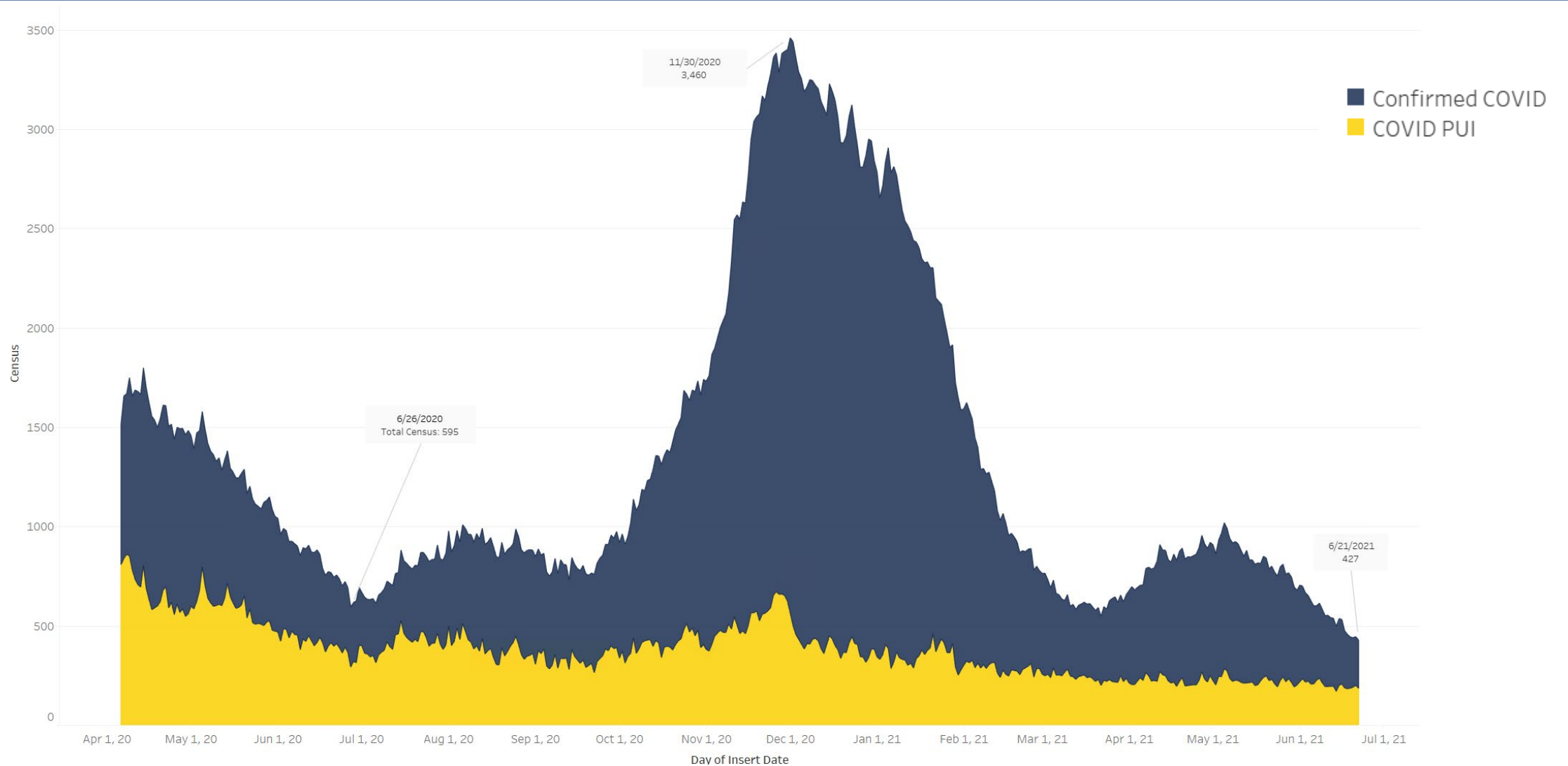

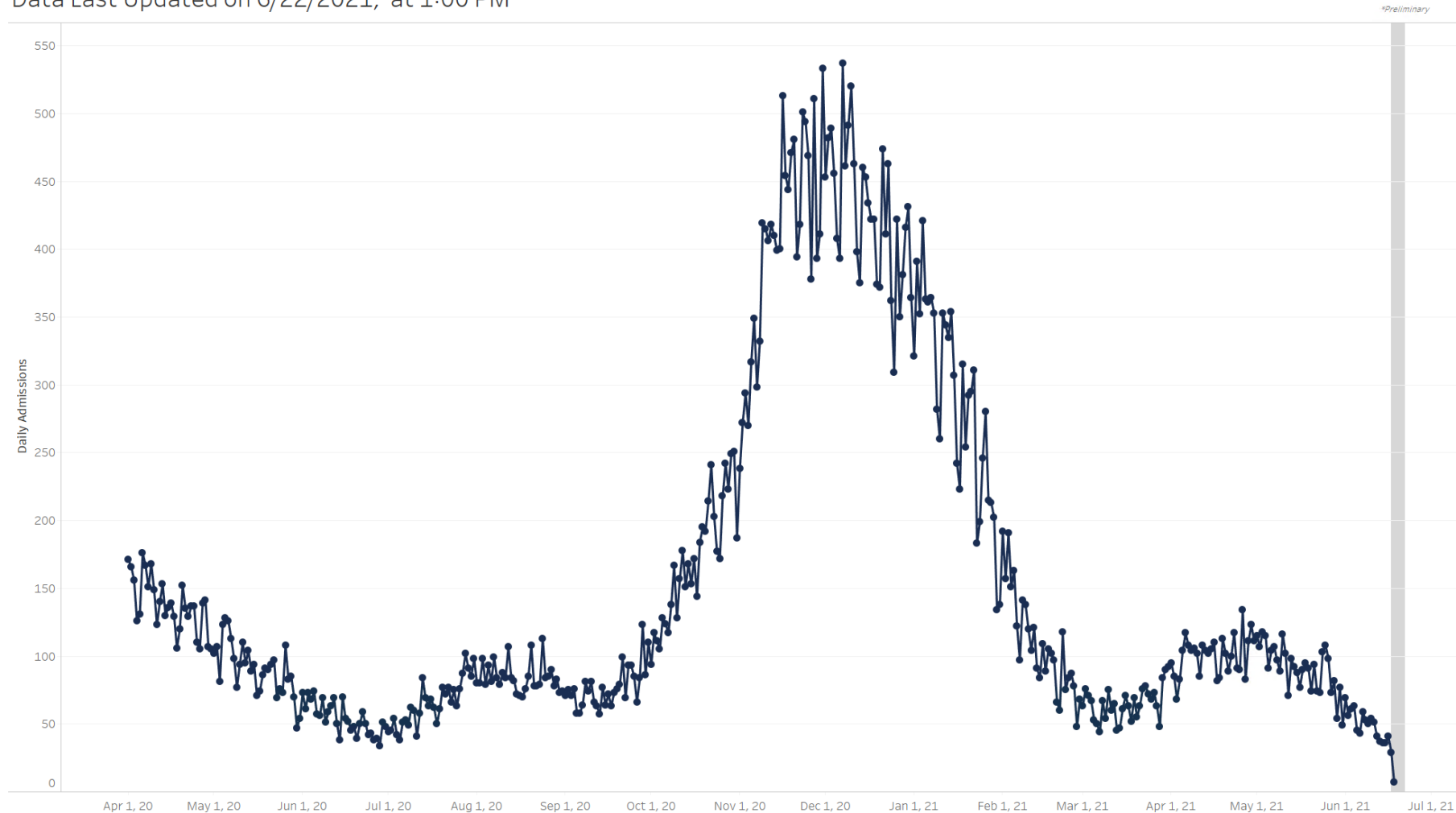
# Statewide COVID-19 Hospital Census

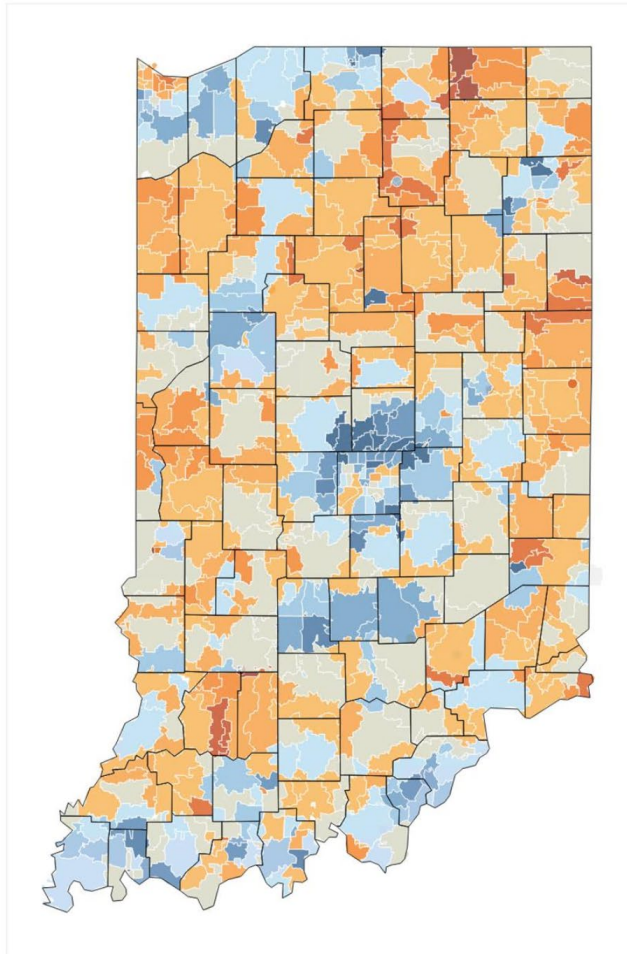
# Vaccine uptake by ZIP code

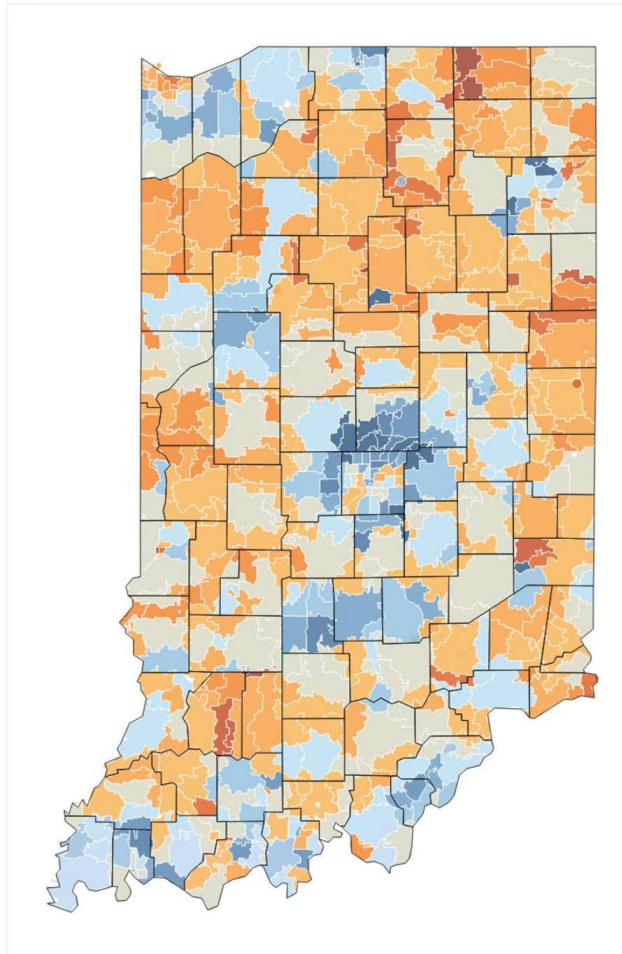

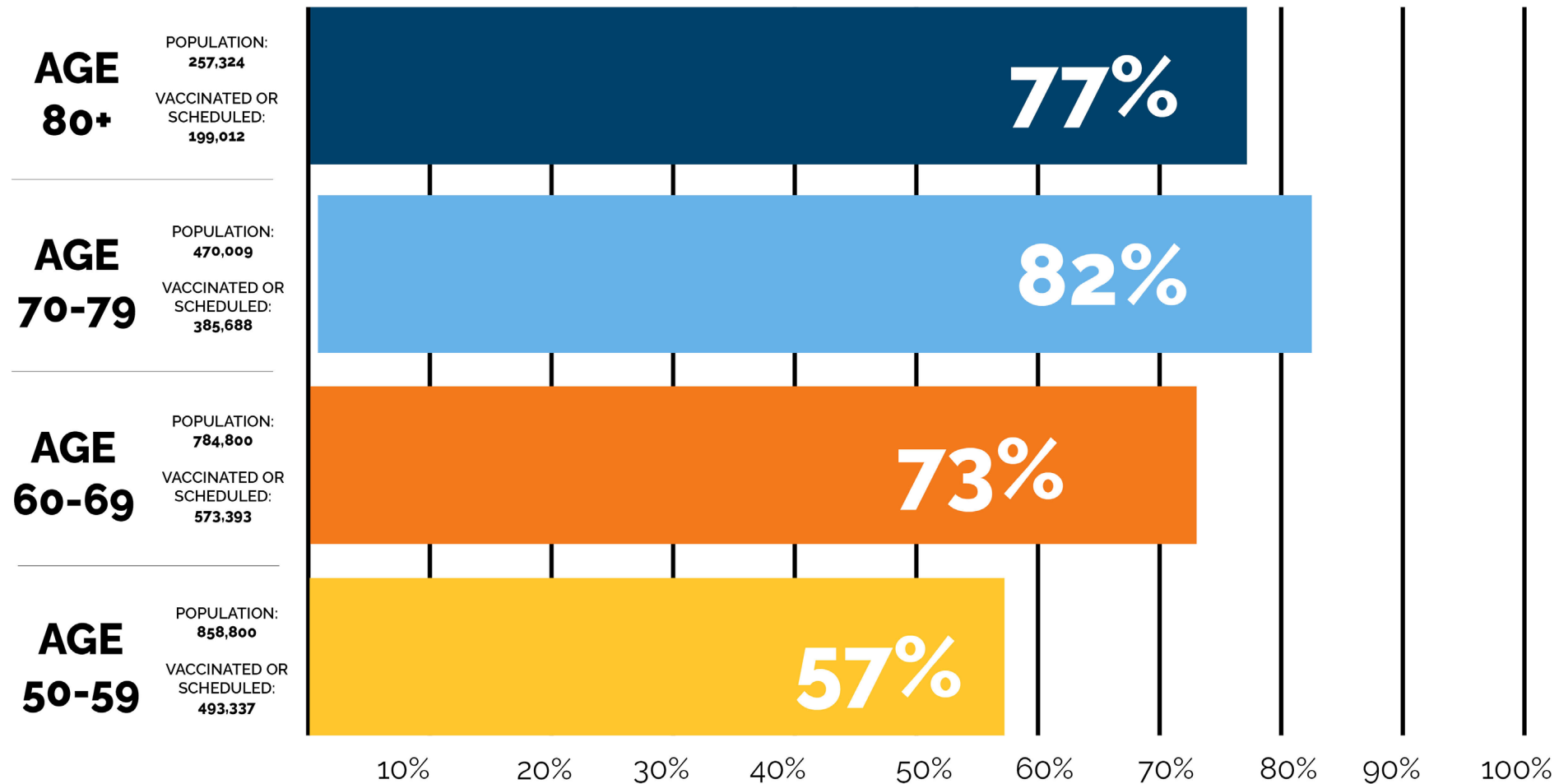
