















COVID-19 and COVID-19 PUI Hospital Census by EM Resource Update - Statewide






Hospital Bed Resource Capacity

The bars in the graph below depict the total number of hospital beds occupied and available each day.




ICU Bed Resource Capacity

The bars in the graph below depict the total number of ICU beds occupied and available each day.





Ventilator Resource Capacity










Gender Distribution for COVID-19 Cases




Gender Distribution for COVID-19 Deaths
