

## **Threat For Severe Storms**

Multiple Severe Hazards Possible This Evening Into Early Wednesday Morning

### **Key Messages**

- Strong-to-severe storms possible this evening into early Wednesday morning
  - ◆ Greatest chance along/west of I-65
- → Highest potential for hail and damaging wind gusts; lower potential for isolated tornadoes

### What has Changed

- → Modified timing overnight (see timing graphic)
- → Increased threat of marginal severe hail


Be weather aware and ready to act. Have multiple ways to receive warning information!

# Timing of Greatest Severe Threat

### **Key Messages**

- → Potential for strong-to-severe storms will move gradually from west to east tonight
- → While this map indicates the timing of greatest severe potential, severe storms may occur outside of the listed ranges
- → With severe weather possible overnight, it is important to have multiple ways to be notified if a warning is issued!
