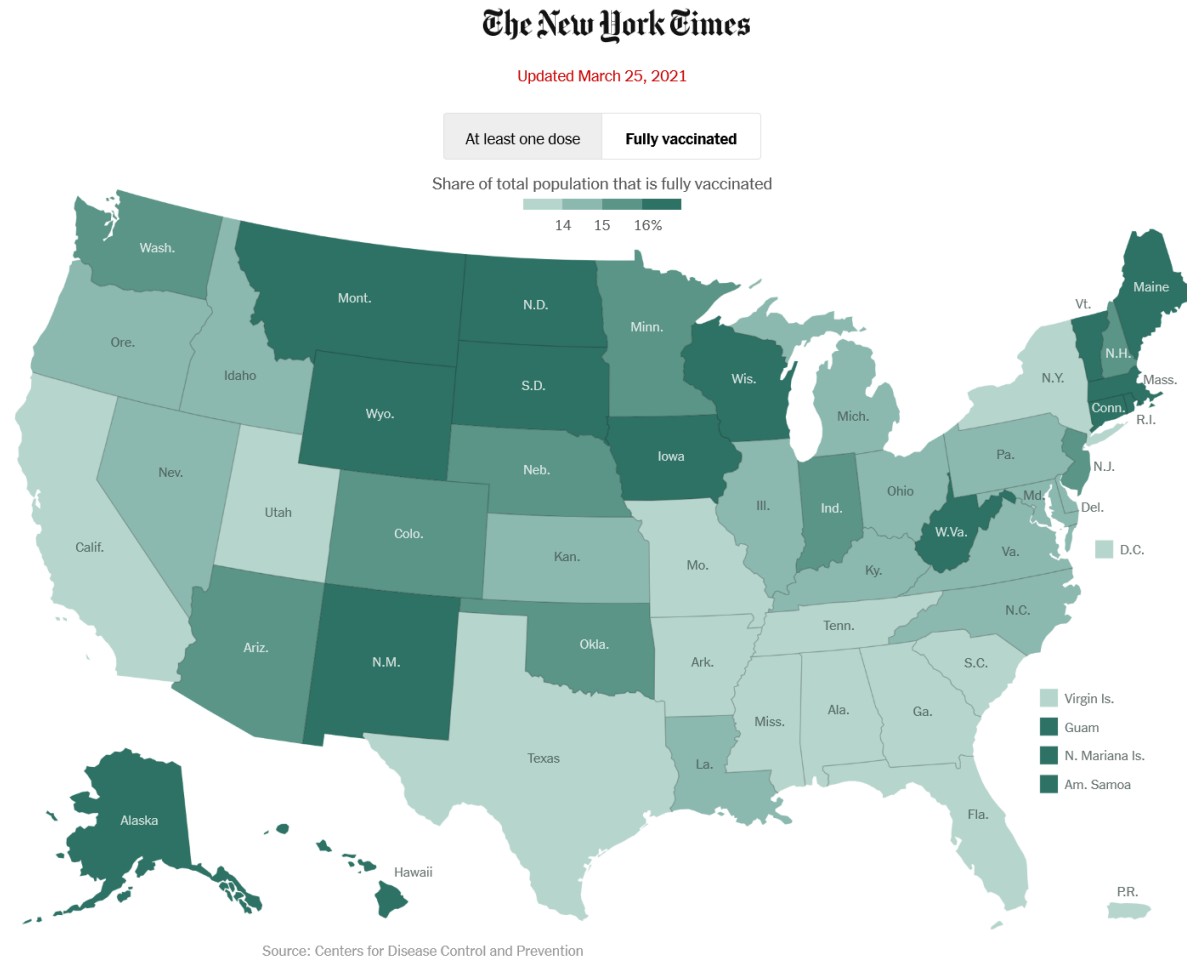

Oregon vaccinations: Current numbers



Number of people vaccinated (at least 1 dose): 1,073,369 (25 percent/80 percent of current eligibles)

National average: 26 percent*

Total population fully vaccinated (2 shots/J&J): 579,122 (12 percent)

- National average: 12 percent*

Oregon daily average doses administered: 26,268

Percentage of all seniors vaccinated: 66 percent (508,250 total – as of March 25th)

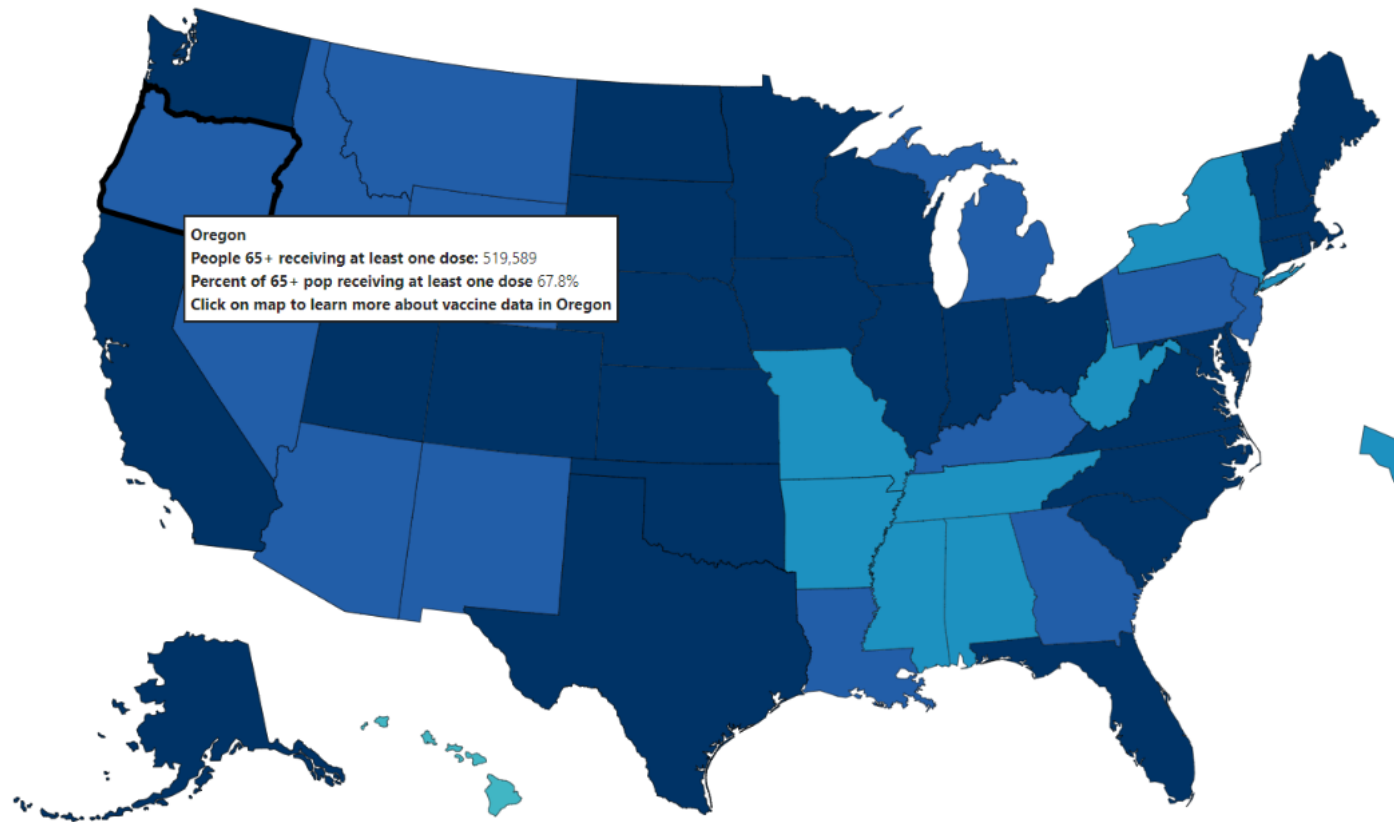

Updated Eligibility Timelines: Phase 1B and Phase 2

Phase 1B Started on January 25, 2021

Groups 1–5

- Childcare providers, early learning and K–12 educators and staff
- People 65 and older

Group 6

Eligible no later than March 29, 2021

- Adults 45–64 with one or more underlying health conditions with increased risk*
- Migrant and seasonal farm workers
- Seafood and agricultural workers
- Food processing workers
- People living in low-income senior housing, senior congregate and independent living
- Individuals experiencing homelessness (sheltered and unsheltered)
- People currently displaced by wildfires
- Wildland firefighters
- Pregnant people 16 and older

Educators:

152,000 approximately

People over 65:

765,000 approximately

Group 7

Eligible no later than April 5, 2021

- Frontline workers as defined by CDC**
- People age 50 and older residing in a multigenerational household
 - » Multigenerational household means a household where:
 - People from three or more generations live, such as a home where an elder lives with a parent and grandchild; or
 - An individual or individuals 50 years and older residing with and caring for a relative who is not their own child (i.e. a grandchild, niece or nephew)
- Adults 16–44 with one or more underlying health conditions with increased risk*

Phase 2

Eligible no later than May 1, 2021

- All people who are 16 and older

March 29, 2021

Group 6 eligible statewide in remaining counties

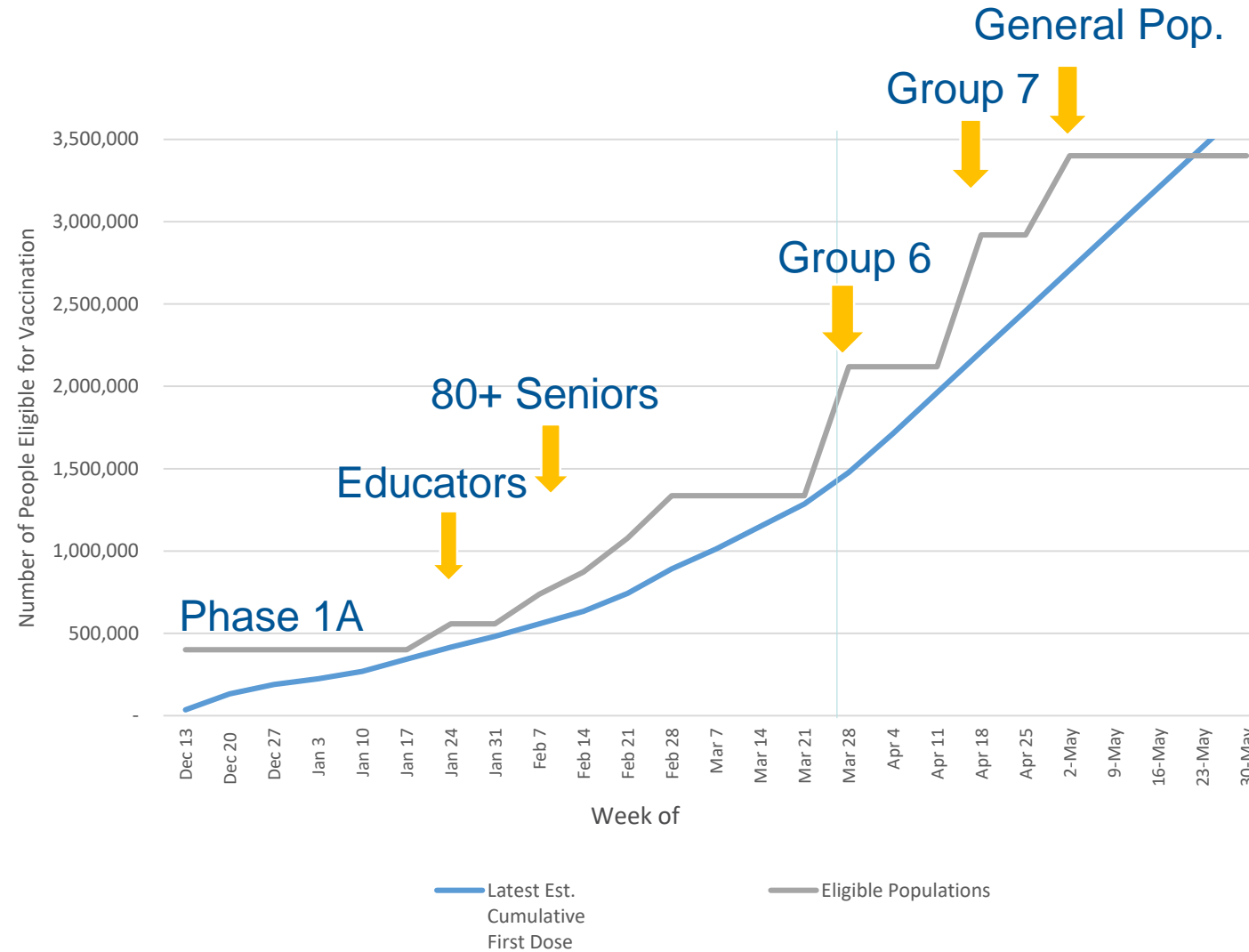
April 5

Group 7 eligibility opens statewide

May 1

Phase 2 eligibility opens statewide (option for counties to open earlier with attestation and documentation)

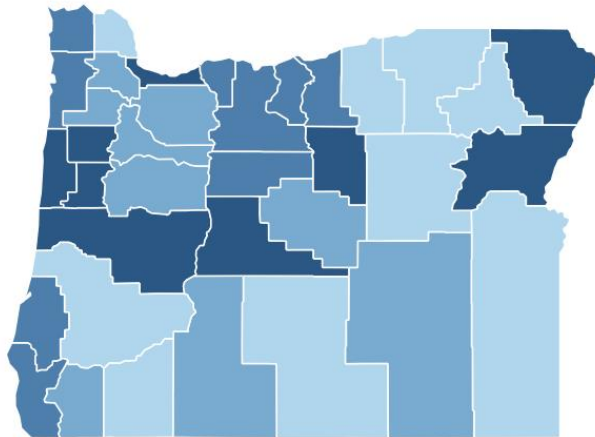

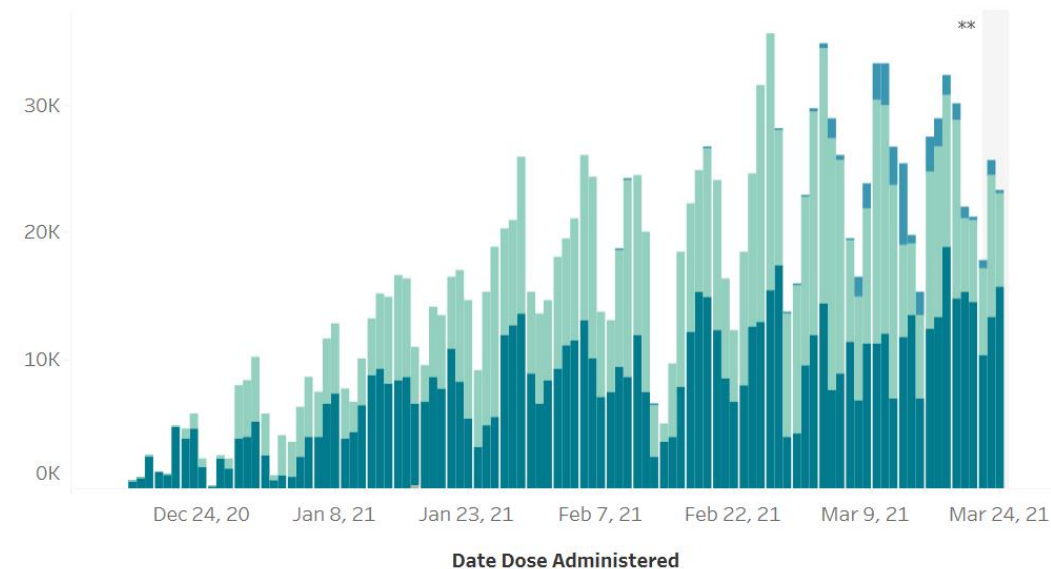

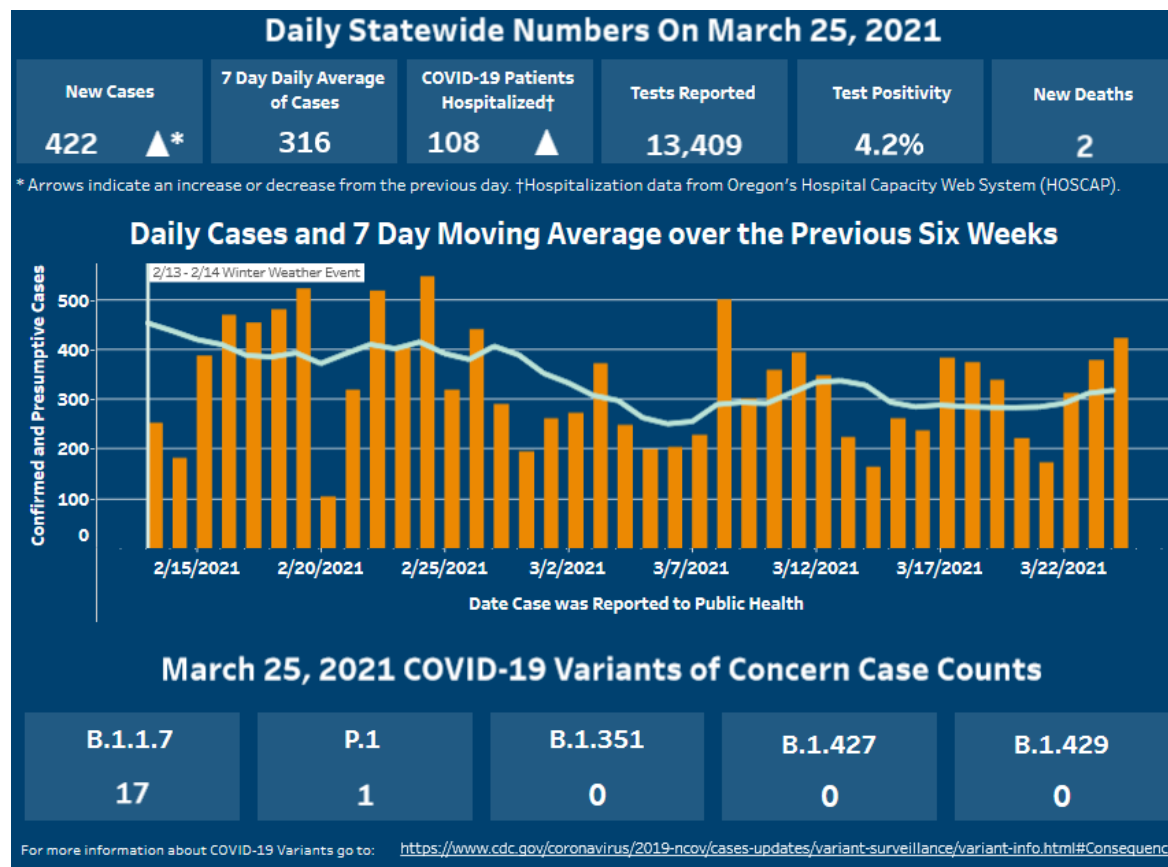

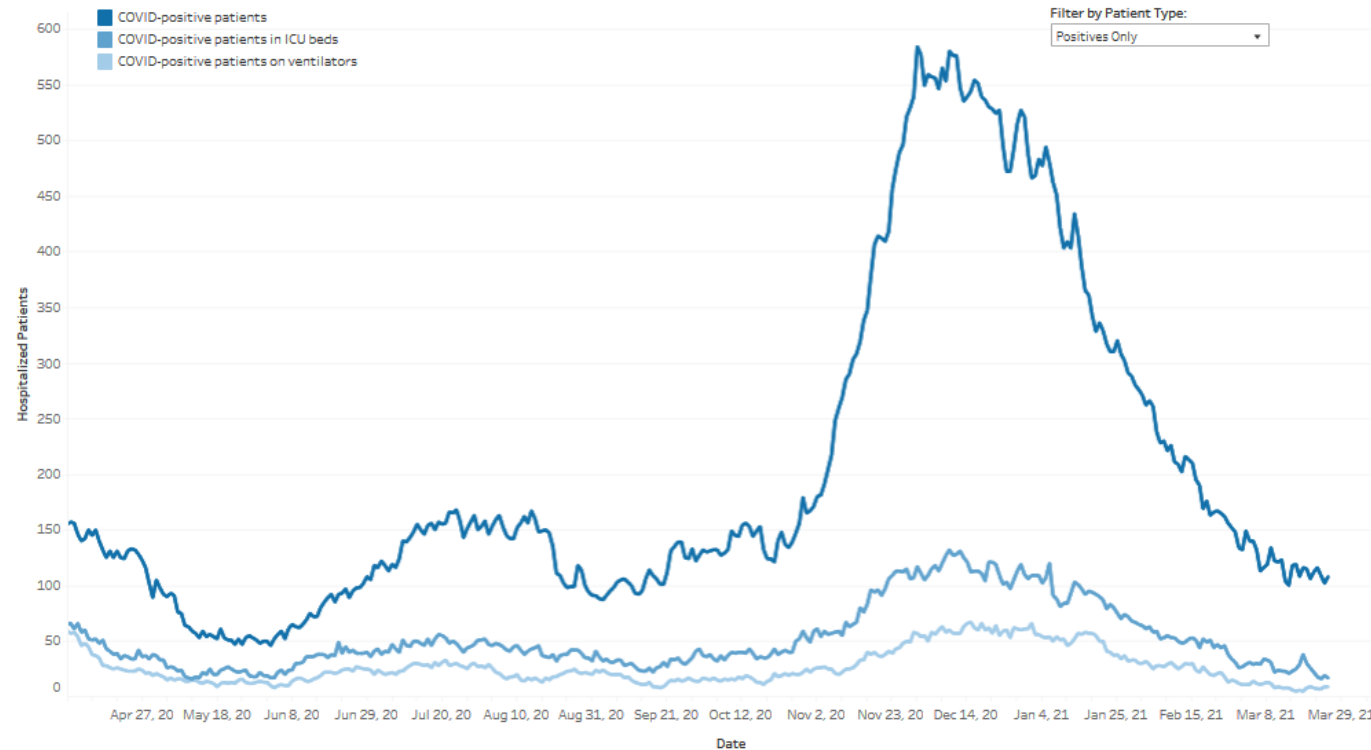

Hospitalizations by Severity

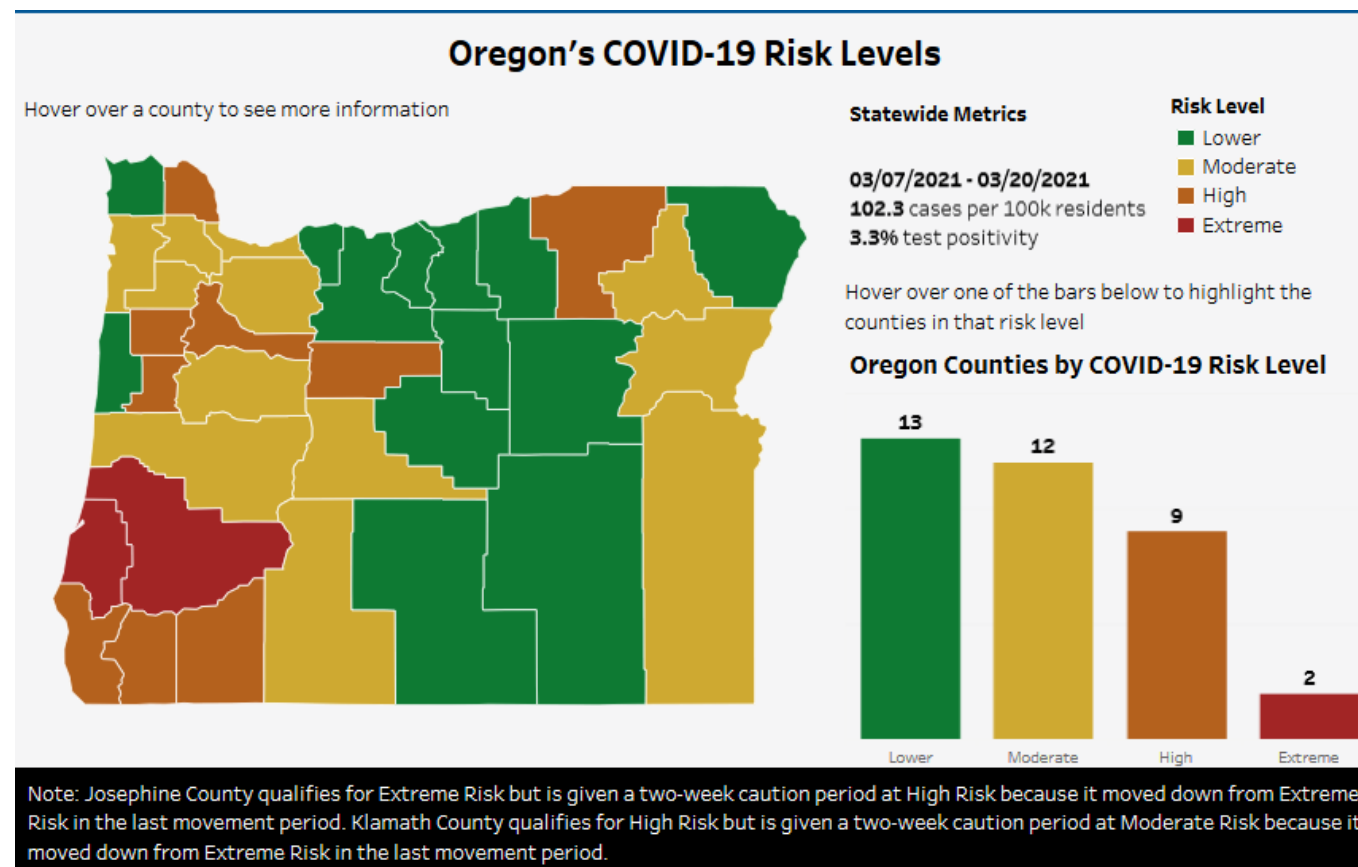
Oregon's Hospitalization Trends by Severity

This chart shows daily COVID-19 hospitalizations and whether patients were in the ICU or on ventilators, as reported to Oregon's Hospital Capacity Web System (HOSCAP)¹. 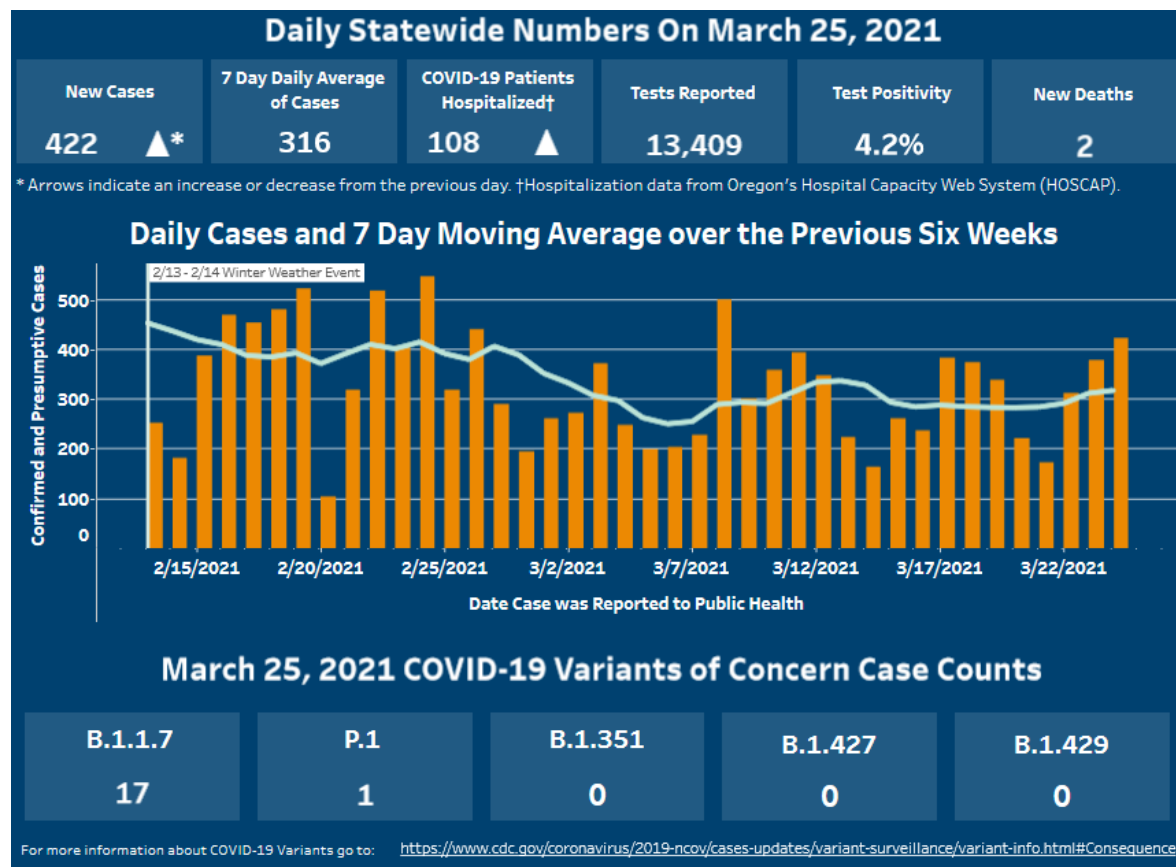
