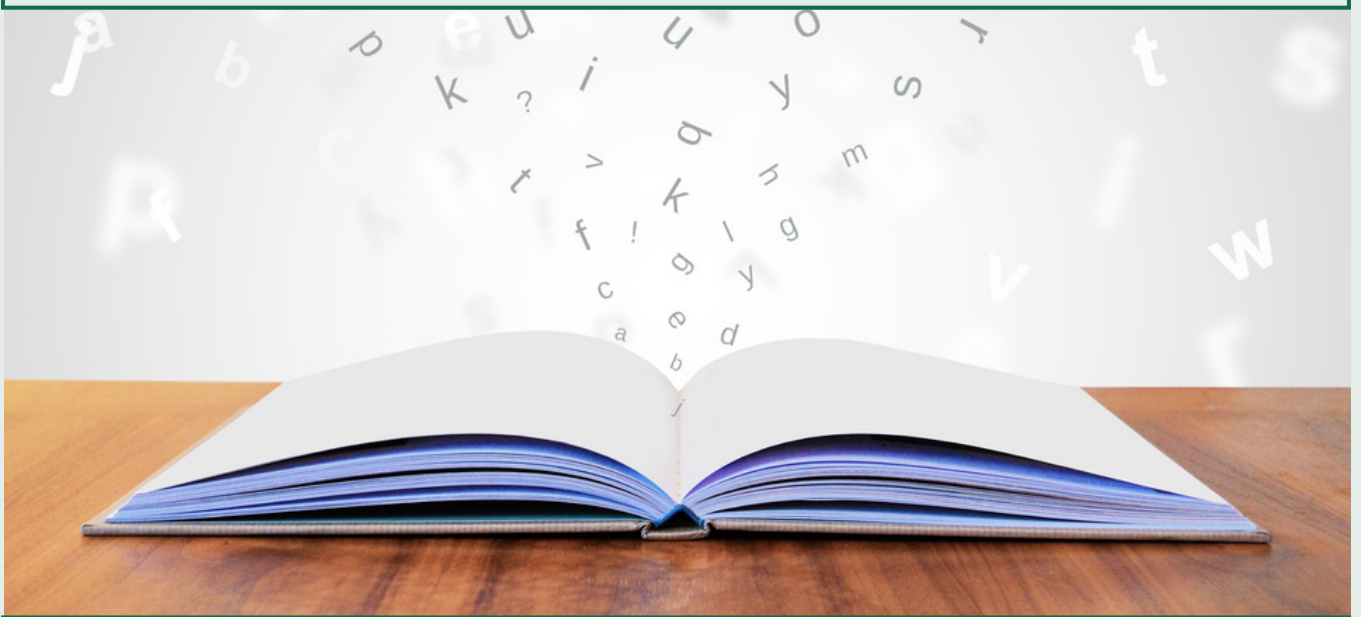


DYSLEXIA

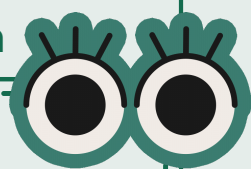
...is a language based learning disability

VISUAL PROBLEMS

do NOT

cause dyslexia



TREATMENT OF VISION PROBLEMS

does not treat dyslexia

PREVALENCE

5% to 20% of school-aged children in
the US have reading disabilities

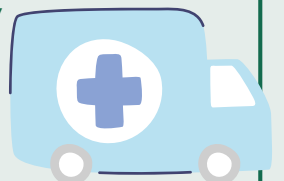
80%

of people with Learning Disabilities
have dyslexia, which is the most
common learning disability



IT'S TIME TO TAKE ACTION

Treat Explicitly
Treat Multisensorally
Treat Systematically



Vision problems can interfere with the
process of reading, but children with
dyslexia or related learning disabilities
have the same visual function and eye
health as other children without such
conditions
