Program of Study

Students will enroll in both:

- SES 761: Coaching and Supervision of Teaching and Learning
- ELC 736: Leadership for Teaching and Learning.

Students will choose from one of four electives (as offered):

- 1. SES 753: Issues and Trends in Special Education
- 2. TED 728: Topics in Curriculum and Instruction
- 3. TED 729: Topics in Math and Science Education
- 4. TED 765: Research in Equity Education

Students will also successfully complete SES 749: Internship in Specialized Education. This course will provide active opportunities to understand the roles of instructional coaches, undertake practice activities typical of instructional coaches, and debrief instructional coaching practice with the principal and/or UNC Greensboro faculty member who has knowledge and experience in coaching and supervising.
