ADHD Five Fast Facts

The National Survey of Children's Health 2016 report reflected 6.1 million 2-17 year olds had ever been diagnosed with ADHD. Of those, 13.6 percent were in the 12-17 age range.





The exact cause of ADHD is not known, but <u>research</u> shows genetics to be part of this neurodevelopmental disorder.

Three <u>sub-types</u> which can range from mild to moderate to severe:

- Predominantly Inattentive type
- Predominantly hyperactive-implusive type
- Combined type
