TITLE: THE APE REFERRAL PROCESS- How to Avoid Pitfalls

DESCRIPTION: The APE referral process is one of the most misunderstood components of Adapted PE services. The majority of “clerical errors” occur at the actual IEP meeting when the team is discussing the question, “Does the student require specially designed instruction in physical education”. Although the options for answers are limited, “yes, no, and N/A” the myths and misconceptions are numerous. Many IEP teams check “yes” because they don’t know what else to do, or what to put into the “Additional Information” box located next to the SDI question. Other IEP teams check “no” because everyone with disabilities automatically goes to the gym for PE period at the same time which is instructed by the special ed case manager or the classroom instructional assistants. Let’s clarify the myths and misconceptions and replace them with facts, not fiction. Let’s avoid predetermination.

TITLE: APE screenings, assessments, standardized, functional, and surveys. How do I pick the right one and then what?

DESCRIPTION: Selecting the appropriate APE evaluation to suit the needs of the individual child in question can be a complicated process. Understanding that the evaluation is only a part of the process is a helpful strategy as the assessment process involves gathering information from a variety of sources which helps put the evaluation data into perspective. This webinar will provide explanations on the following: “how to” of screenings and how that information is used; the four (4) purposes of assessment and how to select the appropriate evaluation; and how to gather all that information into a comprehensive report that can be presented to the IEP team including the parents and caregivers.
