MDHHS issues RFP for recovery support services

LANSING, Mich. – The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) has issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to expand recovery support center services or recovery community center services for individuals seeking long-term recovery from substance-use disorders.

Eligible applicants must be certified or conditionally certified as a Recovery Community Organization (RCO) through Faces and Voices of Recovery. A total of \$3 million is available with a maximum award of \$150,000 per organization. MDHHS anticipates awarding up to 20 grants to qualified organizations.

Grant applications for the Recovery Support Services Competitive RFP must be submitted electronically through the EGrAMS program by 3 p.m., Tuesday, Nov. 14. The program period begins Jan. 1, 2024, and ends Sept. 30, 2024.

A pre-application conference will be held to discuss this funding opportunity and provide instruction on using the EGrAMS system. The pre-application conference will be held Monday, Oct. 23, beginning at 9 a.m., EST, and will last approximately 90 minutes. The conference can be accessed at <https://bit.ly/3RKsfEg>.
