Purpose: Full veterinary services to low-income households at animal care and control agencies and nonprofit human societies. The Veterinary Board of Governors (board) amended WAC 246-933-501 through 246-933-530 and repealed WAC 246-933-550 authorizing animal care and control agencies and nonprofit humane societies to provide full veterinary service to low-income households.
The adopted rule implements Substitute Senate Bill (SSB) 5004 (chapter 142, Laws of 2019), codified in RCW 18.92.250 and 18.92.260. SSB 5004 expands the services that entities may provide to low-income households and directs the board to adopt rules regarding an entity's record keeping and reporting requirements to these clients. The rule identifies the types of records an entity may require from clients as documentation of proof of low-income, explains record retention, and sets a requirement to report upon request to provide clearer and more enforceable standards for these veterinary services.
