### Care Harbor – Los Angeles 2019

Despite unprecedented national and statewide efforts to expand health insurance coverage over the past decade, according to the 2018 Los Angeles County (County) Health Survey, there are still 649,000 County residents who remain uninsured. While the rate of those uninsured has declined from previous years, our residents continue to face many challenges in accessing health services. Approximately 1,652,000 County residents, 21.3% of the population, say that medical care is "somewhat" or "very difficult" to access.

For the last ten years, the County has supported the largest metropolitan free clinics, now operated by the non-profit Care Harbor – Los Angeles (Care Harbor) at venues including the Forum in Inglewood, the Los Angeles Memorial Sports Arena in Exposition Park, the Pyramid in Long Beach, the Fairplex in Pomona and The Reef in Downtown Los Angeles.

Each Care Harbor event builds upon the successes of the previous events, providing a range of health and wellness resources that are usually not available in one single location. Collectively, these twelve events (the first two events were conducted in partnership with Remote Area Medical) have treated over 33,000 patients to deliver comprehensive medical, dental and vision services - care valued at more than \$21 million.

Until all County residents have health insurance, Care Harbor fills significant healthcare service gaps, including medical, dental, vision and mental health services. Patients also have access to preventative and follow-up care, including opportunities to

work with insurance navigators from the County's Department of Public Social Services

who provide education, counseling and enrollment for various qualifying programs. Care

Harbor continues to receive an unprecedented level of support from the local healthcare

community including medical and dental schools, professional societies, hospitals, clinics,

provider organizations, suppliers, and thousands of volunteers, in addition to contributions

from the County Departments of Public Health, Mental Health, and Health Services, and

Public Social Services.

Care Harbor will host the next comprehensive free clinic at The Reef from

November 15, 2019 through November 17, 2019. This year, Care Harbor will dedicate

its first day of service to serving the County's difficult-to-reach, most vulnerable homeless

population. Care Harbor will partner with several homeless services agencies, along with

public and private sector partners, to provide tailored services to ensure the specific

needs of this population can be met.

Care Harbor - LA events have an enduring impact on the health and wellbeing of

thousands of individuals that are served and is an event that is worthy of the County's

continued participation.

I THEREFORE MOVE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

1) Proclaim November 9, 2019 through November 17, 2019 as "Care Harbor

Week" in Los Angeles County (County) and encourage the residents of the

County who are uninsured or underinsured and in need of medical, dental or

vision care to attend the Care Harbor – Los Angeles Event (Event), offered at

no cost to the participants;

2) Encourage County departments to participate in the Event to the extent that

doing so is consistent with their mission and within their budgetary constraints,

including allowing employees to work at the event on County time with the

authorization of their immediate supervisor and administration; and

3) Allow County department representatives to utilize County vehicles to travel to

and from the Event as needed for treatment or educational purposes.
