FSSA clarifies amendment to the AMHH State Plan benefit

The Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) and Division of Mental Health and Addiction (DMHA) received approval from the Centers of Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) for the Adult Mental Health and Habilitation (AMHH) State Plan benefit amendment with an effective date of April 1, 2020.

Changes to AMHH services were published in IHCP Bulletin BT202013. However, in error, BT202013 did not include the removal of peer support services. Peer support services (H0038) are no longer covered under the AMHH State Plan benefit, as they are available as part of the Medicaid State Plan.
