ROTHERHAM COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS GUIDE

Rotherham Borough Council

Rotherham is now following COVID Alert Tier 3 – Very high restrictions which include:

Social and family gatherings (home or garden)

Do not meet indoors or outdoors in private gardens with people not in your household or support bubble. Rule of six applies to parks and public gardens.

Venue closures

Betting shops, casinos and adult entertainment venues must close. Children's soft play

areas must also close.



Sporting Events

No spectating for professional or semi-professional sports



Over 70s and medically vulnerable

Shielding is not required unless you are advised to do so by vour doctor.



Schools and Adult/ **Higher Education**

Open. COVID-19 plans in place.




Bars, leisure and entertainment venues

Pubs and bars must close unless they serve substantial meals. Alcohol can only be served to people when eating.



Public transport

May continue to travel to open venues, but avoid journeys in or out of the Very High alert areas. Exceptions including work and school.



Social visiting suspended.

Compassionate or critical visits allowed at care venue discretion - close family and friends only.



Hospital visits

Check with your local hospital.

Restrictions may apply - close family and friends only.



Indoor cultural venues

Check with venue.

COVID-19 restrictions in place.



Indoor Venues

(including pubs and restaurants)

Only meet with people who you live with or who are in your support bubble.



Holidays

Avoid staying overnight in another part of the UK Further information is available for international travel.



Weddings

Maximum 15 guests.

Receptions are not allowed Check with venue for more details.



Childcare settings (including childminders after-school clubs and nannies)

COVID-19-secure measures in place.

Continue to use.



Religious venues

Open.

Some restrictions may be in place.



Public venues serving food and drink

Table service only.

Face coverinas must be worn unless seated. Test and Trace information required.



Informal childcare with family or friends

Those in support or childcare bubbles can look after children. Households outside these bubbles must not mix



Funerals

Maximum of 30 mourners (where covid safety measures are in place). Maximum of 15 people at a wake / celebration of life



Leisure centres. avms and pools

Open.

Classes are not to take place, however leisure centres and gyms can remain open.



Work inside homes

(for Council or repair services)

with COVID-19 safety measures in place.



Takeaways

Closed between 10pm and 5am.

10pm to 5am delivery service only.



Childcare

(separated parents)

Childcare between separated parents can continue as normal.



Workplace

Work from home where possible.

Travel to work in other areas allowed.



Retail and close contact services

Retail and close contact services open with COVID restrictions in place. Face coverings must be worn

Permitted



(hairdressers, salons, etc)



Enforced restrictions in place
