On February 3, 2021, the State Board of Education voted and approved the revision of the Occupational Preparation courses as follows:

The new course titles and course codes are: (all courses are 1 credit each)

9260BX0 Employment Preparation I Science
9261BX0 Employment Preparation II Citizenship 1A
9262BX0 Employment Preparation II Citizenship 1B
9263BX0 Employment Preparation III Citizenship 2A
9264BX0 Employment Preparation III Citizenship 2B
9265BX0 Employment Preparation IV Math

The Employment Preparation courses should be taught in sequential order as the content is designed to help the student build skills and increase their depth of knowledge over the grades 9-12.

These course requirements apply to students entering the 9th grade for the first time in 2021-2022 and are contained in Section II of the <u>GRAD-004</u> policy.

On March 3, 2021 the State Board of education voted and approved the following: For the Graduating class of 2021:

For the Graduating class of 2020 and 2021:

• SBE waives the CPR graduation requirement for the graduating class of 2020 and 2021. SBE will request a waiver from the CPR legislation for this year's graduating class, NCGS 115C-12.9d and 115C-8 1.25.10.

• For Occupational Course of Study students, SBE reduces the graduation requirement of paid employment to 157 hours.
