Girls in Science: Future Focus is an afterschool program focused on engaging middle school girls in exploring careers in science with likeminded peers. Each week, girls will meet a woman in science or other STEM profession, hear her story, and engage in fun, hands-on activities related to her career.

Running virtually January–March, 2021, Future Focus is an intensive, ten-week program for 6th-and 7th-grade girls and nonbinary students who have shown ability and strong interest in the sciences, especially the natural sciences. The Girls in Science mission is to engage students in hands-on science experiences, connect participants to inspiring women in science and to create a safe atmosphere where diversity can be celebrated and natural curiosities can flourish.
