It's Your Time to Teach!

The East Carolina University College of Education partners with NC community colleges to offer online degree completion in special education adapted or general curriculum, elementary education, or middle grades education through Partnership Teach. Coordinators are located across the state to serve students in their home communities.

GETTING STARTED

To begin, students enroll at a NC community college to complete specific coursework from a Partnership Teach prerequisite checklist. Students then apply to Partnership Teach and enroll at East Carolina University to complete junior and senior level courses online as members of cohort groups. New cohorts are scheduled to begin annually with applications due in January each year for the summer start online special education program (AC or GC).

AFFORDABLE & CONVENIENT

Students receive the benefits of convenient, online course delivery. Tuition is based on ECU's **affordable** distance education rates making it a great value in NC education!

QUALITY

The cohort model provides a small college environment from one of the state's largest producer of teachers. Students also benefit from individual advising, and collaborative friendships with other students. A predetermined plan of study assures timely course delivery.

In conjunction with the online instruction, students are placed in **public schools** to observe and practice what they are learning to develop mastery for future success. A full-time internship is required of all teacher education students at ECU.
