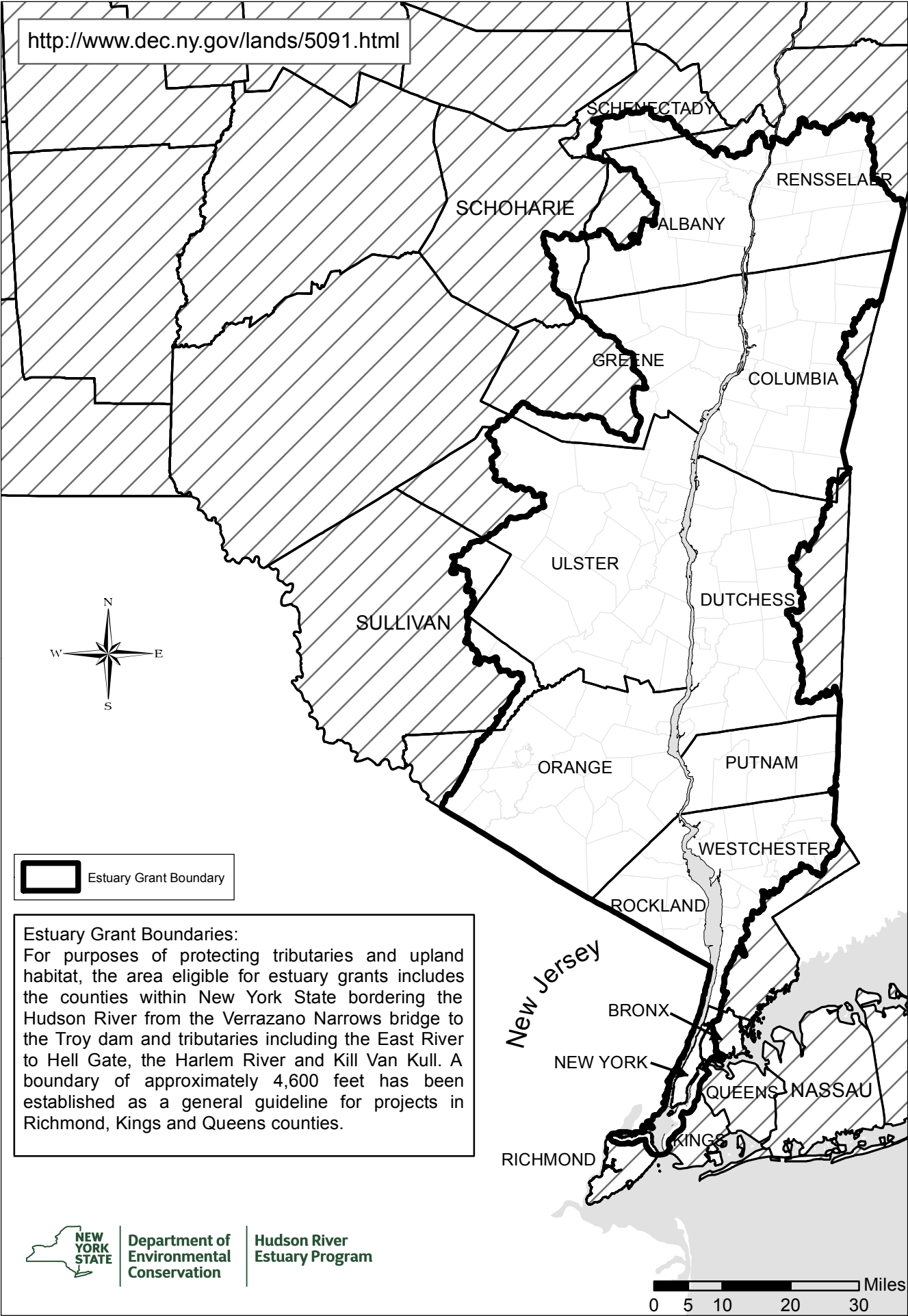


Hudson River Estuary Grants Program Boundaries

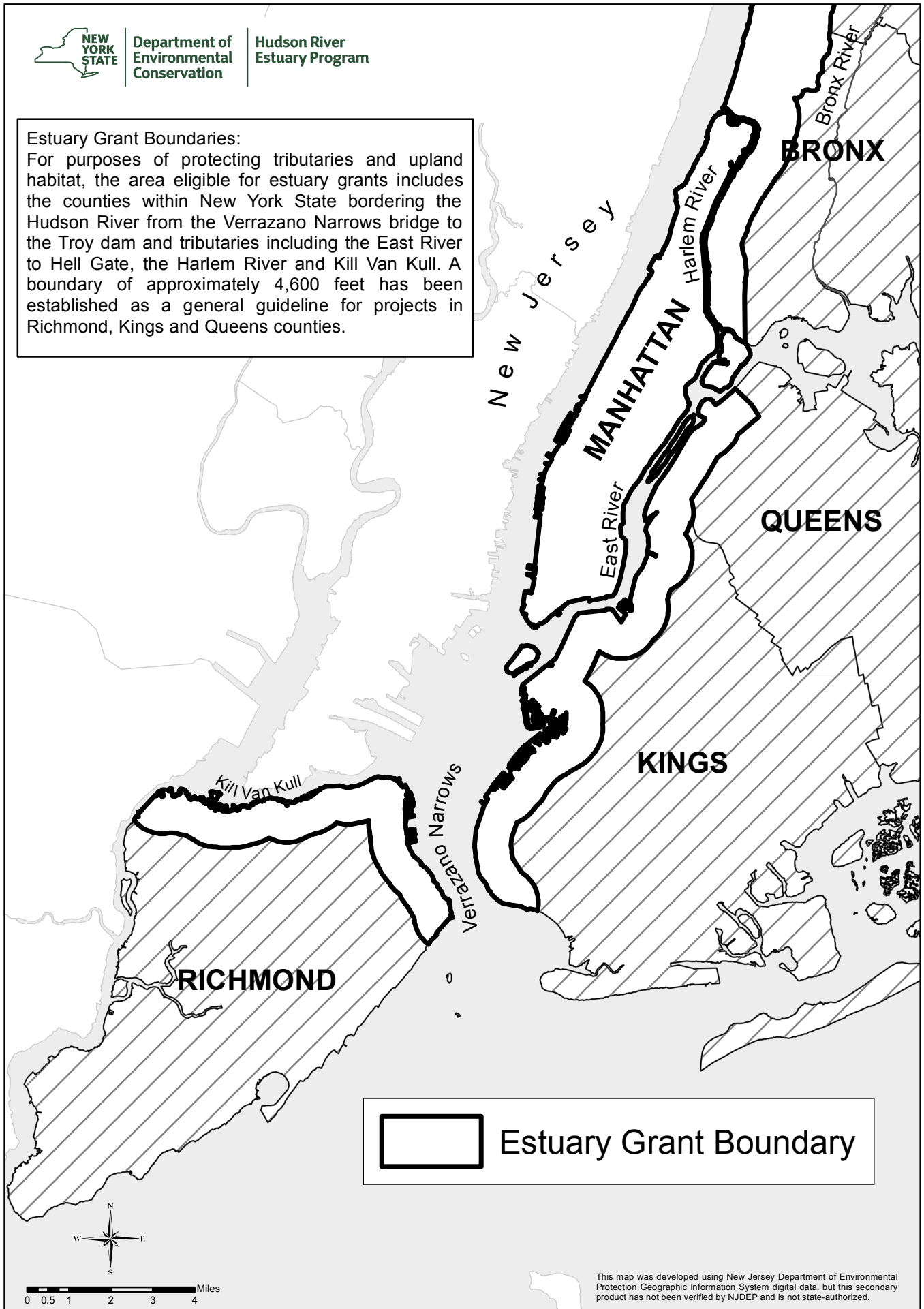

Estuary Grant Boundaries:

For purposes of protecting tributaries and upland habitat, the area eligible for estuary grants includes the counties within New York State bordering the Hudson River from the Verrazano Narrows bridge to the Troy dam and tributaries including the East River to Hell Gate, the Harlem River and Kill Van Kull. A boundary of approximately 4,600 feet has been established as a general guideline for projects in Richmond, Kings and Queens counties.
