

COVID-19 VACCINATION: Self-Attestation

SELF-ATTESTATION FOR MODERATELY TO SEVERELY

IMMUNOCOMPROMISED PEOPLE

Effective August 17, 2021, San Bernardino County, in collaboration with the California Department of Public Health, has opened eligibility for individuals, whose immune systems are moderately to severely compromised, to receive an additional booster dose of mRNA COVID-19 vaccine after the initial two doses. The additional dose is applicable to recipients of Pfizer or Moderna.

An additional booster dose has been prioritized for moderately to severely immunocompromised individuals who have:

- Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
- Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Received a stem cell transplant within the last two years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrish syndrome)
- Advanced or untreated HIV infection
- Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress your immune response
