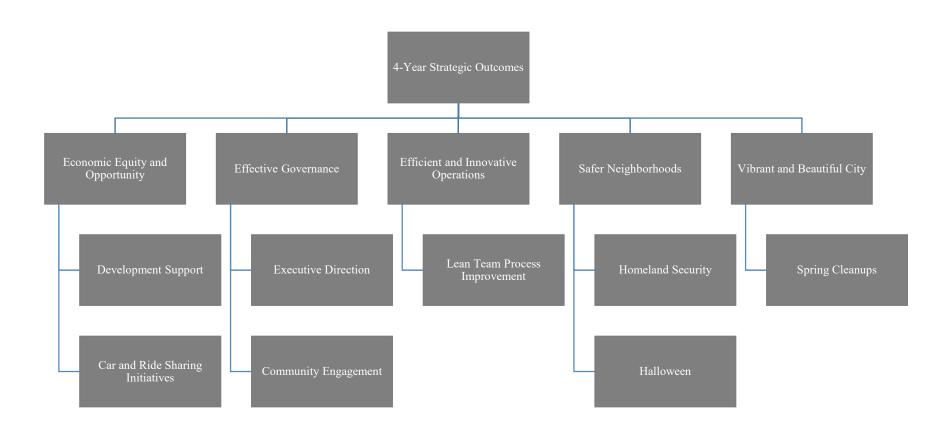
The Mayor serves as the Chief Executive Officer for the City and oversees all City departments through the Executive Team:

The 14-member team includes a manager and deputy manager in each Council district to fight blight and rebuild and strengthen the fabric of neighborhoods. Managers engage thousands of residents and volunteers in major initiatives; help residents form block clubs and community associations; resolve citizens' complaints; and educate residents on City programs and policies.
- **Jobs & Economy Team** identifies, negotiates and facilitates economic development opportunities and projects in coordination with external development agencies and partners.
- Lean Team streamlines city operating processes with project management support and by offering Green Belt Training to city employees in every agency.
