GENERAL INFORMATION

On March 16, 2022, the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) published a guidance document and new standard operating procedures setting maximum residue limits for pesticides in agricultural commodities and products. These commodities and products covered includes: (a) feeds and fodder, (b) milk and milk products, and (c) meat and meat products.

Background: On April 9, 2021, the FSSAI had published the (draft) guidance document – Standard Operating Procedures to Fix Maximum Residue Levels (MRLs) for Pesticides. This guidance document has not been notified to World Trade Organization (WTO) member countries for comments (see, <u>GAIN-INDIA-IN2021-0055-INDIA-FSSAI Publishes Draft Standard Operating Procedures for Fixation of Pesticide MRLs).</u>

The FSSAI, however, is now inviting comments from interested stakeholders within the period of sixty-days from the date of publication of the draft document on its website.
