




### **Coastal Flood Potential**







#### **Peak Wind Gusts**




#### Rainfall Forecast





## **Event Summary**

Confidence is HIGH that this event will occur, producing MINOR to MODERATE impacts.



**Winds:** Moderately strong winds of 30-40 mph are expected, producing minor impacts, especially along the coast.



Coastal Flooding: Minor soundside flooding is expected for Ocracoke and Hatteras Islands.

**Ocean Overwash:** Large surf and ocean overwash is expected for beaches from Hatteras Island north, and for the northern portions of Ocracoke Island. Impacts will be enhanced where dune structures have been weakened or compromised.



**Heavy Rainfall:** Widespread rainfall amounts of 1-3" are expected, with amounts as high as 3-5" possible. This will lead to minor to potentially moderate impacts from flash flooding and river flooding.



Dangerous Marine Conditions: Hazardous winds and seas will occur Thursday through Friday.
