













- --Found coastwide but very uncommon

- --Vague reddish-orange bars on back
- --Rare; found north of Fort Bragg

#### YELLOWMOUTH ROCKFISH

- --Yellow and black blotches inside mouth
- --Rare: found north of Fort Bragg
