2021 WISCONSIN ACT

AN ACT *to amend* 29.184 (6g) (f) of the statutes; **relating to:** the governor's bear tag.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.184 (6g) (f) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.184 (6g) (f) A person may be issued under par. (e)

~~only one Class A bear hunting license in his or her life-time, and the Class A bear hunting license issued to a person under par. (c)~~ shall be valid for only one Class A bear hunting season. The issuance under par. (c) of a license to the person is subject to s. 29.024 (2g).

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."
