Having the foliage off the trees also provides spectacular views of the Des Moines River and Pea's Creek valleys as you descend the hill. Deemed "the most photogenic park in lowa" by its own park manager, you'll be hard pressed to find a better First Day Hike than at Ledges State Park.
