Neighborhoods Served:

• Issaquah Highlands, Issaquah Transit Center, downtown Issaquah

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- New Route 203 serves portions of Route 200 at Issaquah Transit Center, NW Gilman Blvd, Front St N, and Issaquah Highlands
- New Route 202 serves a portion of Route 200 on 17th Ave NW
- Revised Route 269 serves portions of Route 200 between Issaquah Highlands Transit Center SE 56th at 10th Ave NW
- Revised Route 554 service portions of Route 200 on NW Maple St

Why is this change being proposed?

- To provide better all day service to local, Issaquah neighborhoods
- To provide connections from local, Issaquah neighborhoods to Link light rail, and other regional connections
