Platinum Jubilee Community Celebration Grants

Milton Keynes Council has set aside £20,000 grant funding to help Parishes and Community Groups celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. The grants will be delivered in partnership with MK Community Foundation.

Basic information

Small grant applications can be submitted to MK Community Foundation until midday on Friday 25 March at www.mkcommunityfoundation.co.uk/grants/apply-for-a-grant/.

Grant applications can be from £250 but must not exceed £1,000 per organisation.

Applications will be considered by the small grants panel in mid-April and grants will be paid once grant agreements have been signed and returned to MK Community Foundation.

Grants can be used by for a variety of projects or events to celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee, such as:

- Hire or purchase of equipment / decorations for a local event
- Promotion of a local event
- Catering or entertainment for a local event
- Licences or permits for local events
- Decorations for public places (such as bunting etc)

Criteria for assessing small grant applications

Milton Keynes Community Foundation will consider a range of factors in determining small grant applications:

- Need and Demand
- Reach and Impact
- Sustainability
- Partnership
- Inclusion and Diversity
