



#### **FCPS Annual Pass Rates on State Assessments**





School Quality Indicators adopted by the Virginia Board of Education have individual target bands to determine school performance levels. State summary reports and additional details about school quality indicators are available on the <u>VDOE webpage</u>.

- Academic indicators and chronic absenteeism are reported for a total of 195 Fairfax County schools.
- Non-academic indicators (\*)--Graduation and Completion Index (GCI), Dropout Rate, and College Career Civic Readiness Index (CCCRI)-- are reported for a total of 30 Fairfax County schools with a graduating class.

# Virginia Growth Assessment (VGA) Fall 2023 Testing Participation Rates out of FCPS Membership

- Over 95% of students participated in grades 3-8 VGA reading tests and grade 3-6 VGA math tests this fall.
- Lower participation in grades 7-8 VGA math tests reflects enrollment by more students in Algebra 1 and Geometry courses, where there are no VGA tests.
