ROTHERHAM COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS GUIDE

Rotherham Borough Council

Rotherham is now following COVID Alert Tier 3 – Very high restrictions which include:

Social and family gatherings

Do not meet indoors or outdoors in private gardens with people not in your household or support bubble. Rule of six applies to parks and public gardens.

(home or garden)

Bars, leisure and entertainment venues

Pubs and bars must close unless they serve substantial meals. Alcohol can only be served to people when eating.



Indoor Venues (including pubs and restaurants)

Only meet with people who you live with or who are in your support bubble.



Public venues serving food and drink

Table service only.

Face coverinas must be worn unless seated. Test and Trace information required.



Takeaways

Closed between 10pm and 5am.

10pm to 5am delivery service only.

Betting shops, casinos and adult entertainment venues must close.

May continue to travel to open



Sporting Events

No spectating for professional or semi-professional sports.



Long-term residential care venues

Social visiting suspended.

Compassionate or critical visits allowed at care venue discretion - close family and friends only.



Weddings

Maximum 15 guests.

Receptions are not allowed Check with venue for more details.



Those in support or childcare bubbles can look after children. Households outside these bubbles must not mix



Childcare

(separated parents)

Childcare between separated parents can continue as normal.



Funerals

Maximum of 30 mourners (where covid safety measures are in place). Maximum of 15 people at a wake / celebration of life



Workplace

Work from home where possible.

Travel to work in other areas allowed.



Over 70s and medically vulnerable

Shielding is not required unless you are advised to do so by vour doctor.



Hospital visits

Check with your local hospital.

Restrictions may apply – close family and friends only.



Childcare settings (including childminders after-school clubs and nannies)

COVID-19-secure measures in place.

Continue to use.



Leisure centres. avms and pools

Leisure centres and gyms can remain open. COVID secure classes where households do not mix can continue.



Retail and close contact services

(hairdressers, salons, etc)

Retail and close contact services open with COVID restrictions in place. Face coverings must be worn



Schools and Adult/ **Higher Education**

Open.

COVID-19 plans in place.



Indoor cultural venues

Check with venue.

COVID-19 restrictions in place.



Religious venues

Open.

Some restrictions may be in place.



Work inside homes

(for Council or repair services)

Permitted

with COVID-19 safety measures in place.



Enforced restrictions in place
